I (1) $1-1 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF; subcut (14) $1-1 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 3^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles.
(7) $4-3 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles centered over motifs on fabric.

J (1) $33^{\prime \prime} \times 42-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle; centered over panel.
FOR borders 1 and 3: (9) 1-3/4" x WOF strips, sew ends together; subcut (2) 1-3/4" x
K $33^{\prime \prime}$ borders, (2) 1-3/4" $\times 42-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ borders, (2) $1-3 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 45-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ borders and (2) 1-3/4" $\times$ 55" borders.

L (4) $3^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips; subcut (52) $3^{\prime \prime}$ squares.
(4) $1-1 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips; subcut (104) 1-1/4" squares.

## heart blocks

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of fabric $\mathbf{B}, \mathbf{C}$ and L 3" squares.

2. Place (1) fabric B $3^{\prime \prime}$ " square right side down on one lower corner of (1) fabric $\mathbf{H} 4-3 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle. Sew along the drawn line. Trim the stitching to $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ as indicated by the solid line. Press the $\mathbf{B}$ piece open.

3. Sew (1) fabric B 3" square to the other lower corner of the fabric $\mathbf{H} 4-3 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle, trim and press in the same manner to make a square unit. Unit should measure $4-3 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ including seam allowance. Make 4.


Make 4
4. Following steps $2-3$, sew fabric (2) fabric C 3 " squares to (1)H 4-3/4" $\times 5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle. Make 1. Sew fabric L $3^{\prime \prime}$ squares to fabric B, E, F, G, and I $4-3 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles. Make the number indicated.

5. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of fabric $\mathbf{B}, \mathbf{C}$ and L 1-1/4" squares.

6.Place (1) fabric B 1-1/4" square right side down on one end of (1) fabric H 1-1/4" $\times 3^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle. Sew along the drawn line. Trim the stitching to $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ as indicated by the solid line. Press the
 B piece open.
7. Sew (1) fabric B $1-1 / 4$ " square to the other end of the $\mathbf{H}$ rectangle, trim and press in the same manner to make rectangle unit. Unit should measure $1-1 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 3^{\prime \prime}$ including seam
 allowance. Make 6.
8. Following steps 6-7, sew fabric (2) fabric C $1-1 / 4$ " squares to (1) H 1-1/4" $\times 3$ " rectangle. Make 2. Sew fabric L 1-1/4" squares to fabric B, E, F, G, and I 1-1/4" $\times 3^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles. Make the number indicated.

9. Sew the rectangle units together in pairs matching the fabrics. Make the number indicated.

10. Sew the rectangle pair units to the top of the large rectangle unit. Make the number of heart blocks indicated

## HEART BORDERS

11. Sew (6) center heart blocks alternating with the fabric $\mathbf{A}, \mathbf{C}$ and $\mathbf{D} 1-1 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips. Use slightly more than $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam allowance so strip measures $5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 35-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ including seam allowance. Then add fabric $\mathbf{B}$ hearts to end. Make 1 each.

12. Sew the heart blocks alternating with the fabric A, C and D $1-5 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips. Use slightly less than $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam allowance so border measures $5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 45^{\prime \prime}$ including seam allowance. Make 1 each.

## BORDERS

13. Sew (1) fabric K 1-3/4" x 42-1/2" border to sides of fabric J panel. Sew (2) fabric B 1-3/4" squares to ends of $1-3 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 33^{\prime \prime}$ borders. Sew to top and bottom of quilt.
14. Sew (1) side heart border to sides of quilt. Sew top and bottom heart borders to quilt.
15. Sew (1) fabric K 1-3/4" $\times 55^{\prime \prime}$ border to sides of quilt. Sew (2) fabric C $1-3 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ squares to ends of fabric $\mathbf{K}(2) 1-3 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 45-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ borders. Sew to top and bottom of quilt.
16. Sew (1) fabric G 2-3/4" $\times 58-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ borders to sides of quilt. Sew (1) Fabric G (2) $2-3 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 55^{\prime \prime}$ top and bottom border to quilt.


FINISHING: Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich. Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using fabric B 2-1/4" strips.
