ADDITIONAL MATERIALS

4 yards backing fabric Thread to match fabrics Rotary cutter, ruler and mat 63" x 71" batting Sewing machine Basic sewing supplies

HEART BLOCKS

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of fabric **B**, **C** and **L** 3" squares.

2. Place (1) fabric **B** 3" square right side down on one lower corner of (1) fabric **H** 4-3/4" x 5-1/2" rectangle. Sew along the drawn line. Trim the stitching to 1/4" as indicated by the solid line. Press the **B** piece open.

3. Sew (1) fabric **B** 3" square to the other lower corner of the fabric **H** 4-3/4" x 5-1/2" rectangle, trim and press in the same manner to make a square unit. Unit should measure 4-3/4" x 5-1/2" including seam allowance. Make 4.


4. Following steps 2-3, sew fabric (2) fabric **C** 3" squares to (1)**H** 4-3/4" x 5-1/2" rectangle. Make 1. Sew fabric **L** 3" squares to fabric **B**, **E**, **F**, **G**, and **I** 4-3/4" x 5-1/2" rectangles. Make the number indicated.






5. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of fabric B, C and
 L 1-1/4" squares.

6.Place (1) fabric **B** 1-1/4" square right side down on one end of (1) fabric **H** 1-1/4" x 3" rectangle. Sew along the drawn line. Trim the stitching to 1/4" as indicated by the solid line. Press the **B** piece open.

7. Sew (1) fabric **B** 1-1/4" square to the other end of the **H** rectangle, trim and press in the same manner to make rectangle unit. Unit should measure 1-1/4" x 3" including seam allowance. Make 6.








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
8. Following steps 6-7, sew fabric (2) fabric **C** 1-1/4" squares to (1) **H** 1-1/4" x 3" rectangle. Make 2. Sew fabric **L** 1-1/4" squares to fabric **B**, **E**, **F**, **G**, and **I** 1-1/4" x 3" rectangles. Make the number indicated.



9. Sew the rectangle units together in pairs matching the fabrics. Make the number indicated.


11. Sew (6) center heart blocks alternating with the fabric **A**, **C** and **D** 1-1/4" x 5-1/2" strips. Use slightly more than 1/4" seam allowance so strip measures 5-1/2" x 35-1/2" including seam allowance. Then add fabric **B** hearts to end. Make 1 each.





12. Sew the heart blocks alternating with the fabric **A**, **C** and **D** 1-5/8" x 5-1/2" strips. Use slightly less than 1/4" seam allowance so border measures 5-1/2" x 45" including seam allowance. Make 1 each. Left Side Border

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BORDERS

13. Sew (1) fabric **K** 1-3/4" x 42-1/2" border to sides of fabric **J** panel. Sew (2) fabric **B** 1-3/4" squares to ends of 1-3/4" x 33" borders. Sew to top and bottom of quilt.

14. Sew (1) side heart border to sides of quilt. Sew top and bottom heart borders to quilt.

15. Sew (1) fabric K 1-3/4" x 55" border to sides of quilt. Sew (2) fabric C 1-3/4" squares to ends of fabric K (2) 1-3/4" x 45-1/2" borders. Sew to top and bottom of quilt.

16. Sew (1) fabric **G** 2-3/4" x 58-1/2" borders to sides of quilt. Sew (1) Fabric **G** (2) 2-3/4" x 55" top and bottom border to quilt.



FINISHING: Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich. Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using fabric **B** 2-1/4" strips.
