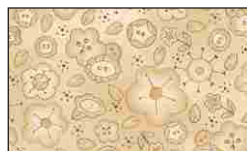

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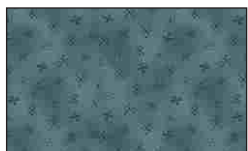

KEY	CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS
A	(1) 3-1/2" x WOF* strips; subcut (8) 3-1/2" squares. (2) 2" x WOF strips; subcut (4) 2" x 9" rectangles and (4) 2" x 3-1/2" rectangles.
B-E	From each: (1) 2" x WOF strip; subcut (1) 2" x 9" rectangle and (2) 2" squares.
F	Fussy Cut (4) 6-1/2" squares.
G	(1) 4" x WOF strip; subcut (2) 4" squares. (2) 3-1/2" x WOF strips; subcut (4) 3-1/2" x 18-1/2" rectangles.
H	(1) 4" x WOF strip; subcut (2) 4" squares. Trim remainder of strip to 2-1/2" wide and set aside for binding. (2) 2-1/2" x WOF strips; set aside for binding.

*WOF = Width of Fabric Selvage to Selvage

PIECING INSTRUCTIONS

Arrange (1) 2" square of Fabrics B-E, as shown below. Sew together and press to form a four-patch unit. Make 1.

Arrange (1) 2" Fabric B square, (1) 2" x 3-1/2" Fabric A rectangle and (1) 2" Fabric C square, as shown below. Sew together and press. Make 1.



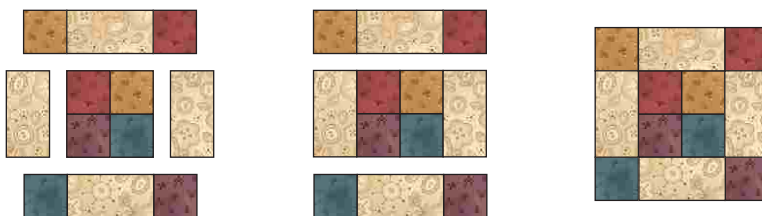

Arrange (1) 2" Fabric D square, (1) 2" x 3-1/2" Fabric A rectangle and (1) 2" Fabric E square, as shown. Sew together and press. Make 1.



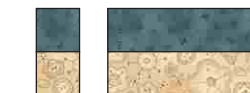

Arrange all pieced units and (2) remaining 2" x 3-1/2" Fabric A rectangles, as shown below. Sew together into horizontal rows. Sew rows together and press to complete block. Block should measure 6-1/2" square.

Sew a 2"x9" Fabric A rectangle lengthwise to a 2"x9" Fabric B rectangle. Press and cross-cut (4) 2" x 3-1/2" sections. Repeat with remaining Fabric A rectangles and Fabrics C-E 2" x 9" rectangles.

Sew Fabric A/B and Fabric A/C units together to form a four-patch. Make 4.



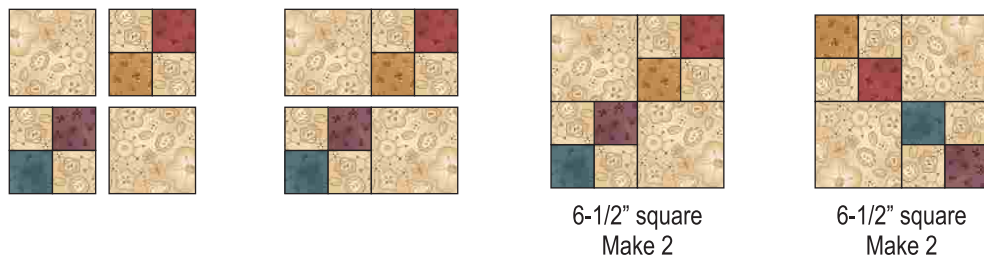

Sew Fabric A/D and Fabric A/E units together to form a four-patch. Make 4.

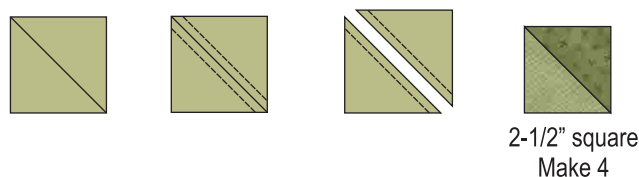

Arrange four-patch units and 3-1/2" Fabric A squares as shown below. Sew into horizontal rows. Sew rows together and press to complete block. Make 2 and 2 mirror-image blocks.

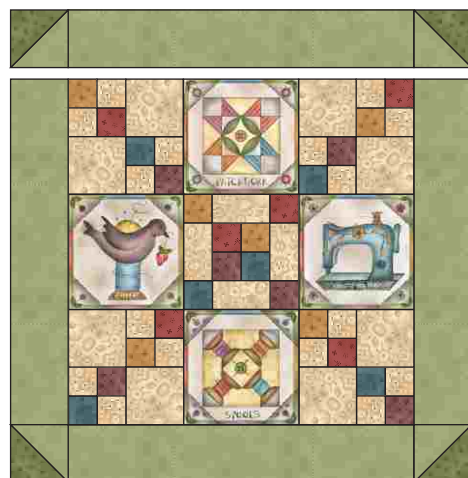


Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (2) 4" Fabric G squares. With right sides together, place a 4" Fabric G square on a 4" Fabric H square. Stitch 1/4" on each side of drawn line. Cut along drawn line and press seam open. Square up each unit to measure 3-1/2" square. Repeat to make a total of 4.



Arrange 6-1/2" pieced blocks and 6-1/2" fussy cut squares as shown below. Sew together into horizontal rows and press. Sew rows together and press to complete quilt center.

Sew a 3-1/2" x 18-1/2" Fabric G border to each side of quilt center and press. Sew a Fabric G/H pieced unit to each end of remaining borders, as shown. Sew border to top and bottom of quilt and press to complete quilt top.



Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich. Baste and quilt. Bind using 2-1/2" Fabric H strips.
