CHRISTMAS WISHES

*WOF = Width of Fabric Selvage to Selvage

KEY	CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS
A	Fussy Cut Rectangles from Panel (1) 15-1/2" x 21-1/2" rectangle and (4) 9" x 10-1/2" rectangles.
B	Fussy Cut Lengthwise Strips (2) 6" x 54-1/2" (bunnies playing in snow/larger stripe), (2) 4-1/2" x 54-1/2" and (2) 4-1/2" x 20" (bunnies with Christmas tree/smaller stripe). See quilt diagram for reference.
C	Cut (2) 9" x WOF strips; subcut (1) 9" x 30-1/2" rectangle and (1) 9" x 14-1/2" rectangle.
D	Cut (1) 9" x WOF strip; subcut (1) 9" x 20" rectangle, (1) 9" x 6" rectangle and (1) 9" x 4-1/2" rectangle.
E	Cut (1) 9" x WOF strip; subcut (1) 9" x 20" rectangle, (1) 9" x 6" rectangle and (1) 9" x 4-1/2" rectangle.
F	Cut (2) 9" x WOF strips; subcut (1) 9" x 30-1/2" rectangle and (1) 9" x 14-1/2" rectangle.
G	Cut (7) 5-1/2" x WOF strips and set aside for borders.
H	Cut (7) 2-1/2" x WOF strips and set aside for binding.

PIECING INSTRUCTIONS

Sew a 9" x 30-1/2" Fabric C rectangle to the left side of a 9" x 10-1/2" Fabric A rectangle. Press toward Fabric C. Sew a 9" x 14-1/2" Fabric C rectangle to opposite side of Fabric A rectangle and press toward Fabric C.



Sew a 4-1/2" x 54-1/2" Fabric B strip to top of pieced unit, as shown. Press toward Fabric B. Sew a 6" x 54-1/2" Fabric B strip to bottom of unit and press toward Fabric B. Set aside.



Sew a 9" x 30-1/2" Fabric F rectangle to the right side of a 9" x 10-1/2" Fabric A rectangle. Press toward Fabric F. Sew a 9" x 14-1/2" Fabric F rectangle to opposite side of Fabric A rectangle and press toward Fabric F.



Sew a 4-1/2" x 54-1/2" Fabric B strip to bottom of pieced unit, as shown. Press toward Fabric B. Sew a 6" x 54-1/2" Fabric B strip to top of unit and press toward Fabric B. Set aside.



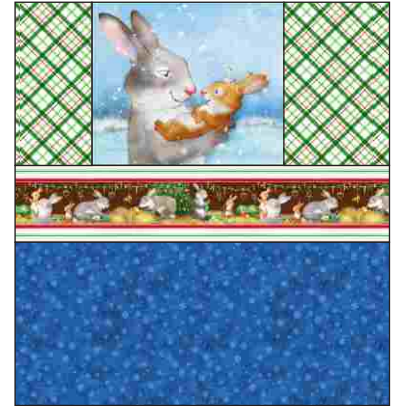
Sew a 9"x 4-1/2" Fabric D rectangle to the left side of a 9" x 10-1/2" Fabric A rectangle. Press toward Fabric D. Sew a 9" x 6" Fabric D rectangle to opposite side of Fabric A rectangle and press toward Fabric D.



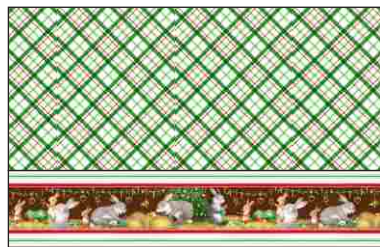
Sew a 4-1/2" x 20" Fabric B rectangle to the top of a 9" x 20" Fabric E rectangle. Press toward Fabric B.



Sew first unit to the top of the second unit and press toward bottom unit. Set aside.

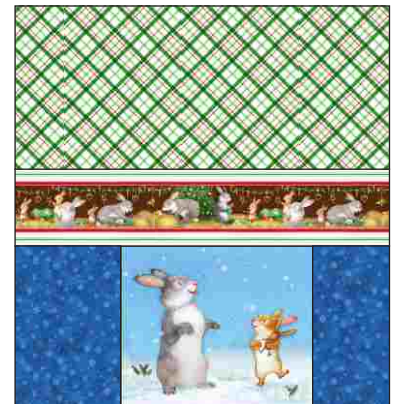


Sew a 4-1/2" x 20" Fabric B rectangle to the bottom of a 9" x 20" Fabric D rectangle. Press toward Fabric B.



Sew a 9"x 6" Fabric E rectangle to the left side of a 9" x 10-1/2" Fabric A rectangle. Press toward Fabric E. Sew a 9" x 4-1/2" Fabric E rectangle to opposite side of Fabric A rectangle and press toward Fabric E.

Sew first unit to the top of the second unit and press toward bottom unit.



Sew pieced units to the 15-1/2" x 21-1/2" Fabric A rectangle, as shown below. Press both seams toward Fabric A.



Sew all pieced sections together horizontally, as shown below. Press seams in either direction to complete quilt top.



Sew (7) Fabric G strips together end to end. Cut (2) 5-1/2" x 57-1/2" and sew to sides of quilt center. Press toward Fabric G strips. Cut (2) 5-1/2" x 64-1/2" borders and sew to top and bottom of quilt center. Press toward Fabric G strips to complete quilt top.



Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich. Baste and quilt. Bind using 2-1/2" Fabric H strips.
