





KEY	CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS
A	 (4) 2-1/2" x 42" strips; subcut (16) 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangles and (16) 2-1/2" squares, (6) bow template 2 and (6) bow template 4. (2) 2-1/4" x 42" strips; subcut (10) 2-1/4" x 2-1/2" rectangles and (2) 1-3/4" x 8-1/2" rectangles. (1) 2" x 42" strip; subcut (12) 2" x 2-3/4" rectangles. (1) 1-3/4" x 42" strip; subcut (4) 1-3/4" x 8-1/2" rectangles. (2) 1-1/2" x 42" strips; subcut (12) 1-1/2" x 7" rectangles.
В	(1) 7" x 42" strip; subcut (2) 7" x 3" rectangles, (2) 5-1/2" x 3-7/8" rectangles and (1) 5-1/2" x 1-3/4" rectangle, (1) bow template 1 and (1) bow template 1 reversed.
С	(2) 2-1/2" x 42" strips; subcut (32) 2-1/2" squares.
D	(1) 5-1/2" x 42" strip; subcut (1) 5-1/2" x 1-3/4" strip, (1) bow template 1 and (1) bow template 1 reversed.
Е	 (1) 3" x 42" strip; subcut (4) 3" x 7" rectangles, (1) 1-1/2" x 7" rectangle, (1) 1-3/4" x 5-1/2" rectangle. (1) 2-1/2" x 42" strip; subcut (1) bow template 1, (1) bow template 1 reversed, (1) bow template 3, and (1) bow template 3 reversed.
F	(1) 3" x 42" strip, subcut (2) 3" x 7" rectangles, (3) 1-3/4" x 5-1/2" rectangles, (3) bow template 1 and (3) bow template 1 reversed.
G	(1) 2-3/8" x 42" strip; subcut (2) bow template 3 and (2) bow template 3 reversed and (2) 1-1/2" x 7" rectangles.
Н	(4) 1-3/4" x 38-3/4" borders.
ı	(1) 8-1/2" x 42" strip; subcut (20) 8-1/2" x 1-3/4" sashing strips. (5) 1-3/4" x 42"strips; subcut (20) 1-3/4" x 8-1/2" sashing strips.
J	(2) 4-1/2" squares fussy cut over Christmas "darlings".
K	(2) 4-1/2" squares fussy cut over Christmas "darlings". (4) 1-3/4" squares fussy cut over candy cane motifs.
L	(2) 41-1/4" x 4" LOF side borders. (4) 30" x 3-3/4" WOF strips; sew ends together. Subcut (2) 4" x 48-1/4" top and bottom borders.



KEY	CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS
M	(1) 7" x 42" strip; subcut (2) 7" x 3" rectangles and (12) 1-3/4" squares.
N	(1) 7" x 42" strip; subcut (2) 7" x 1-1/2" rectangles, (4) 5-1/2" x 3-7/8" rectangles, (2) bow template 3 and (2) bow template 3 reversed.
0	(1) 7" x 42" strip; subcut (2) 7" x 3" rectangles, (1) 7" x 1-1/2" rectangle, (2) 5-1/2" x 3-7/8" rectangles, (1) bow template 1 and (1) bow template 1 reversed.
Р	(1) 5-1/2" x 42" strip; subcut (4) 5-1/2" x 3-7/8" rectangles and (13) 1-3/4" squares. FOR BINDING: (5) 2-1/4" x 42" strips; trim ends diagonally. Sew short ends together.

STAR BLOCK

Note direction of candy canes as indicated by arrows pointing down toward the bottom of the candy cane. Fold square wrong sides together along the drawn line to double check that the direction of the candy canes is correct before sewing.

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (32) A 2-1/2" squares.

2. Lay (1) \mathbb{C} 2-1/2" square on one end of (1) \mathbb{A} 2-1/2 x 4-1/2" rectangle. Sew along the drawn line. Trim the fabric 1/4" from the stitching as indicated by the solid line. Press the \mathbb{C} piece open.





3. Sew (1) **C** 2-1/2" square to the other end of the **A** rectangle, trim and press in the same manner to make a bottom flying geese unit. Unit should measure 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" including seam allowance. Make 1.

4. Repeat steps 1-2 reversing the direction of the arrows to make top flying geese unit.





- 5. Repeat steps 1-2 with candy canes pointed as shown to make the right side flying geese unit.
- 6. Repeat step 3 reversing the direction of the arrows to make the left side flying geese unit.





- 7. Sew (2) A 2-1/2" squares to ends of top and bottom flying geese units. Make 1 each.
- 8. Sew left and right side flying geese units to sides of (1) J 4-1/2" square to make (1) square unit. Make 1 each.
- **9.** Sew flying geese units to top and bottom of square unit matching seams. Make 2.
- **10.** Repeat steps 2-9 using **K** 4-1/2" square. Make 2.












GIFT BLOCK 1

- 11. Sew (1) B bow template 1 to (1) A bow template 2. Sew (1) B bow template 1 reversed to bow template 1 to complete bow unit. Make 1.
- 12. Sew (2) A 2-1/4" x 2-1/2" rectangles to ends of bow/rectangle unit. Make 1.
- **13.** Sew (2) **O** 5-1/2"x 3-7/8" rectangles to sides of (1) **B** 5-1/2" x 1-3/4" rectangle to make gift unit. Make 1.
- **14.** Sew bow/rectangle unit to top of gift unit. Sew (1) A 1-3/4" x 8-1/2" rectangle to top of bow/ rectangle unit.












15. Repeat steps 10-13 using the following bow/gift fabric combinations: **F/N, F/P, E/B** and **D/N**. Make the number of blocks indicated.











GIFT BLOCK 2


- **16.** Sew (1) **N** bow template 3 to (1) **A** bow template 4. Sew (1) **N** bow template 3 reversed to bow template 4 to complete bow unit. Make 1.
- 17. Sew (2) A 2" x 2-3/4" rectangles to ends of bow/rectangle unit. Make 1.
- **18.** Sew (2) **E** 3" \times 7" rectangles to sides of (1) **N** 1-1/2" \times 7" rectangle. Sew (2) **A** 1-1/2" \times 7" rectangles to sides of **E** 3" \times 7" rectangles to complete gift unit. Make 1.
- 19. Sew bow/rectangle unit to top of gift unit. Make 1.
- **20.** Repeat steps 15-18 using the following bow/gift fabric combinations: **G/M, N/B, O/E, G/O** and **E/F**. Make 1 each




















ASSEMBLING THE QUILT

21. Arrange the star blocks and gift blocks 1 and 2 in (4) rows of (4) blocks each. Sew (4) blocks alternating with (5) I sashing strips to make the block rows. Note the diagonal direction of the ribbons on the sashing strips.



- **22.** Sew (4) I sashing strips alternating with (3) P 1-3/4" squares and (2) M 1-3/4" squares together. Note the diagonal direction of the ribbons on the sashing strips. Make 3.
- **23.** Sew (4) I sashing strips alternating with (3) M 1-3/4" squares and (2) P 1-3/4" squares together. Make 2.



- **24.** Sew (5) sashing rows and (4) block rows together matching seams. Alternate sashing rows 1 and 2 beginning with row 1 so **M** and **P** squares alternate.
- **25.** Sew (1) **H** 1-3/4" x 38-3/4" border to sides of quilt. Sew (2) **K** 1-3/4" squares to ends of (2) **H** 1-3/4" x 38-3/4" borders. Sew to top and bottom of quilt.
- **26.** Sew (1) \mathbf{L} 41-1/4" x 4" LOF border to sides of quilt. Sew (1) \mathbf{L} 4" x 48-1/4" border to top and bottom of quilt.

FINISHING: Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich. Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using fabric **P** 2-1/4" strips.
