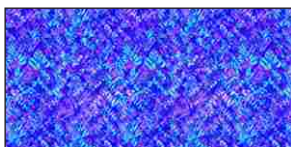

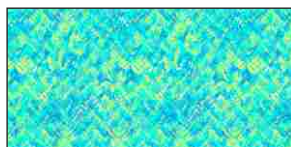

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WOF = Width of Fabric Selvage to Selvage

KEY	CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS
<b>A-J</b>	From each cut (1) 9-1/2" x WOF strip; subcut (3) 9-1/2" squares.
<b>K-N</b>	Set aside for appliqué.
<b>O</b>	Cut (13) 2-1/2" x WOF strips; set (7) strips aside for binding.
<b>P</b>	Cut (7) 5-1/2" x WOF strips.

## APPLIQUÉ INSTRUCTIONS:

Trace leaf shape (page 5) onto the paper side of fusible web (8) times. DO NOT cut the traced leaf on the drawn line. Cut them apart at least 1/8" outside the line. Lay the fusible web leaf shape, paper side up, on the wrong side of a Fabric K-N fat quarter. Take care to leave room on the fat quarter to cut two leaves. Fuse to the fat quarter, following manufacturer's directions. Repeat with remaining leaf shapes to cut (2) leaves from each fat quarter.

Peel paper from leaf shapes and center on (8) Fabric A-J 9-1/2" squares (see diagram to mimic our quilt). Fuse to the squares, following manufacturer's directions.

Stitch the appliqués using the stitch of your choice. You can use blanket stitch, zig zag or straight stitch.

## PIECING INSTRUCTIONS:

Arrange (30) 9-1/2" Fabric A-J squares as shown in diagram. Sew squares together into horizontal rows and press seams in opposite directions (see diagram on page 4).

Sew rows together and press to complete quilt center.

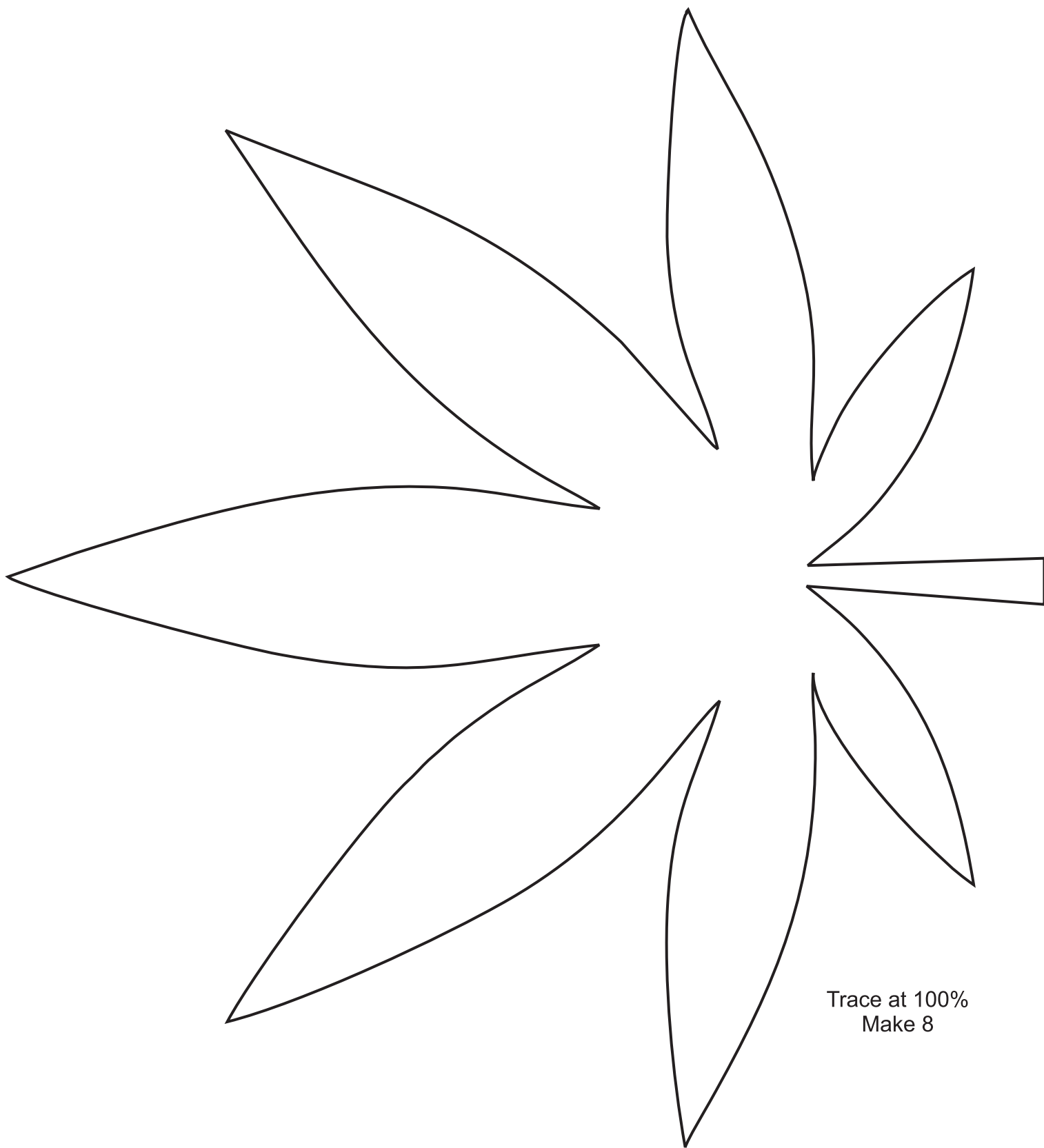
Sew (6) 2-1/2" Fabric O strips together, end to end. Cut (2) 54-1/2" long inner border strips and sew to sides of quilt center. Press toward inner borders. Cut (2) 49-1/2" long inner border strips and sew to top and bottom of quilt center. Press toward inner borders.



Sew (7) 5-1/2" Fabric P strips together, end to end. Cut (2) 58-1/2" long outer border strips and sew to sides of quilt center. Press toward outer borders. Cut (2) 59-1/2" long outer border strips and sew to top and bottom of quilt center. Press toward outer borders to complete quilt top.

Layer quilt top with batting and backing and quilt as desired.  
Bind using (7) 2-1/2" Fabric O strips.
