





KEY	CUTTING INTRUCTIONS		
	 Fusible Web: On the smooth side of fusible web, trace (1) of each template from the template pages (Legs 1 & 2, Shoes 1 – 2, Shoe Bottom, Straps 1-5). Roughly cut out each template outside of the traced line and set aside for Fabric A-I cutting instructions. (PLEASE NOTE: Templates have been reversed. Instructions for raw edge applique are included in this pattern. For turn under applique, add an ½ " – ½" to each template and proceed using your preferred method.) 		
A	 Cut (18) 2" x WOF strips. Subcut the following: (8) 2" x 30 ½" strips. (16) 2" x 18 ½" strips. (16) 2" x 6 ½" rectangles. Cut (6) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Piece strips for length using diagonal seams. From the long strip, subcut the following: (2) 1 ½" x 54 ½" Side Inner Border strips. (2) 1 ½" x 56 ½" Top/Bottom Inner Border strips. 		
В	 Cut (7) 2 ¼ " x WOF strips for binding. Cut (4) 3 ½ " x WOF strips. Subcut the following: (4) 3 ½ " x 30 ½ " strips. (12) 3 " squares. Cut (1) 3 " x WOF strip. Subcut (12) 3 " squares. Cut (1) 2 ½ " x WOF strip. Subcut (12) 2 ½ " squares. 		
С	 Cut (2) 3 ½" x WOF strips. Subcut (4) 3 ½" x 18 ½" strips. Cut (7) 5" x WOF strips. Piece strips for length using diagonal seams. From the long strip, subcut the following: (2) 5" x 56 ½" Side Outer Border strips. (2) 5" x 65 ½" Top/Bottom Outer Border strips. 		
D	 Cut (4) 3 ½" x WOF strips. Subcut the following: (4) 3 ½" x 18 ½" strips. (8) 3 ½" x 6 ½" rectangles. Cut (3) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Subcut the following: (32) Template A pieces. Turn the template 180° after each cut to best utilize fabrics. (8) 2 ½" squares. 		
E	• From yardage, cut (1) 18 ½" x 18 ½" square for the Center Applique Block.		
F	 Cut (3) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Subcut (48) 2 ½" squares. Cut (2) 3" x WOF strips. Subcut (24) 3" squares. Use the remaining yardage to fuse Shoe Straps 1-5 to the wrong side of fabric. Cut out the templates on the traced lines and set aside for the Center Applique Block. 		




G	 Cut (2) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Subcut (32) 2 ½" squares. Cut (4) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Keep strips folded wrong sides together to create mirror image reverse templates when cutting. Subcut (32) Template B pieces and (32) reverse/mirror image Template B pieces. Use the remaining yardage to fuse Shoes 1-2 to the wrong side of fabric. Cut out the templates on the traced lines and set aside for the Center Applique Block. 	
н	• Fuse (1) Shoe Bottom fusible web template to the wrong side of fabric. Cut out the template on the traced line and set aside for the Center Applique Block.	
ı	Use the yardage to fuse Leg pieces 1-2 to the wrong side of fabric. Cut out the templates on the traced lines and set aside for the Center Applique Block.	


Piecing Instructions:

Star Block A Assembly:

- 1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (24) 3" Fabric F squares.
- 2. Place each Fabric F square with (1) 3" Fabric B square, RST.
- 3. Sew a $\frac{1}{4}$ away from either side of the drawn diagonal line on each set of squares.
- 4. Cut along the drawn diagonal line on each set of squares, creating a total of (48) HST units. Trim all HST units to measure $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished.




- 5. Arrange (4) HST units, (1) 2 ½" Fabric B square and (4) 2 ½" Fabric F squares to form Star Block A as shown.
- 6. Sew Star Block A together, pressing seams away from the HST units. Once complete, Star Block A should measure $6 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $6 \frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished.
- 7. Repeat to create (12) Star Block A.






Star Block A Assembly:

- 8. Arrange (1) Fabric G Template B piece and (1) Fabric G reversed Template B piece on either side of (1) Fabric D Template A piece.
- 9. Attach Template B pieces to the Template A pieces one at a time, press seams toward Template B to create (1) V Block Unit for Star Block B. Trim the V Block Unit to measure 2 ½" x 2 ½" unfinished.
- 10. Repeat to create (32) V Block Units.




- 11. Arrange (4) V Block Units, (1) 2 ½" Fabric D square and (4) 2 ½" Fabric G squares to form Star Block B as shown.
- 12. Sew Star Block B together, pressing seams away from the V Block Units. Once complete, Star Block B should measure 6 ½' x 6 ½" unfinished.
- 13. Repeat to create (8) Star Block B.





Center Applique Block Assembly:

- 14. Remove the paper from the glue side of each fusible web piece to prepare for applique.
- 15. Fold the 18 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric E square into quadrants and press to mark the exact center. This will help align applique templates with the graphics shown on page 6.
- 16. The applique will be placed in layers and stitched down in stages. First, place Legs 1 & 2, Fuse in place. Then place Straps 1, 3, 4, and 5. Fuse in place.
- 17. Use the decorative stitch and thread color of your choice to stitch down each individual applique piece. Press again and snip threads.
- 18. Place Strap 2, Shoes 1 & 2, and the Shoe Bottom as shown and fuse in place. Stitch down. This completes Center Applique Block assembly. Block should measure 18 ½" x 18 ½" unfinished.










Quilt Assembly:

- 19. Sew (1) 2" x 6 ½" Fabric A rectangle to either side of (1) 3 ½" x 6 ½" Fabric D rectangle as shown. Press toward Fabric D. Unit should measure 6 ½" x 6 ½" unfinished.
- 20. Repeat to create (8) units as described in Step 19.




- 21. Sew (1) 2" x 18 ½" Fabric A strip to either side of (1) 3 ½" x 18 ½" Fabric D strip as shown. Press toward Fabric D. Unit should measure 6 ½" x 18 ½" unfinished.
- 22. Repeat to create (4) units as described in Step 21.






- 23. Sew (1) 2" x 30 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A strip to either side of (1) 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 30 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip as shown. Press toward Fabric B. Unit should measure 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 30 $\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished.
- 24. Repeat to create (4) units as described in Step 23.










- 25. Sew (1) 2" x 18 ½" Fabric A strip to either side of (1) 3 ½" x 18 ½" Fabric C strip as shown. Press toward Fabric C. Unit should measure 6 ½" x 18 ½" unfinished.
- 26. Repeat to create (4) units as described in Step 25.





- 27. Arrange Star Block A, Star Block B, the Center Applique Block and all units created in Steps 19-26 as shown to form the quilt top center.
- 28. Sew the quilt top center together by adding layers onto the Center Applique Block in stages. Press all seams toward the units created in Steps 19-26. The quilt top center should measure $54 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $54 \frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished.















- 29. Attach (1) 1 ½" x 54 ½" Fabric A Side Inner Border to either side of the quilt top center. Press outward.
- 30. Attach (1) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 56 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A Top/Bottom Inner Border to the top and bottom of the quilt top center. Press outward. The quilt top should measure 56 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 56 $\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished at this step.
- 31. Attach (1) 5" x 56 ½" Fabric C Side Outer Border to either side of the quilt top. Press outward.
- 32. Attach (1) 5" x 65 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C Top/Bottom Outer Border to the top and bottom of the quilt top center. Press outward to complete quilt assembly. The quilt top should measure 65 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 65 $\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished.





Finishing the Quilt:

- 33. Sandwich the quilt top with batting and backing. Baste quilt layers together.
- 34. Quilt as desired.
- 35. Bind quilt using (7) Fabric B 2 1/4" x WOF strips.




