| A | (1) $4-1 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip; subcut (4) $4-1 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 5^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles and (8) $2-3 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 1-1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles. |
| B | (5) 2-1/2" $\times$ WOF strips; sew ends together. Subcut (2) $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 50-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ borders and (2) $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 42-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ borders. |
| C | (2) 5" $\times$ WOF strips; subcut (10) 5 " squares. |
| D | (3) 2-1/2" $\times$ WOF strips; sew ends together. Subcut (2) $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 36-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ borders and (2) $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 24-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ borders. |
| E | (2) 5" $\times$ WOF strips; subcut (10) 5 " squares. |
| F | (1) $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip; subcut (4) $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares and (8) $1-3 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles (cup \# 2). |
| G | (1) $5^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip; subcut (2) $5^{\prime \prime}$ squares, (8) 2-3/4" squares, and (16) 1-1/4" squares. |
| H | (1) $5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip; subcut (8) $5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles (cup \#4), <br> (8) $1-1 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 1-3 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles (handle \#1), <br> (8) $1-1 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 2-3 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles (handle \#5), (8) 2 " $\times 1-1 / 2$ rectangles (handle \#6) and (8) $2-3 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles (handle \#7). <br> FOR BINDING: <br> (5) $2-1 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 42^{\prime \prime}$ strips, sew short ends together. |
| I | (5) 1 " $\times$ WOF strips; sew ends together. Subcut (2) $1^{\prime \prime} \times 49-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ borders and <br> (2) $1^{\prime \prime} \times 38-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ borders. |
| J | Centering design, fussy cut: (1) $23-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 36-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle centered over panel and (4) $1^{\prime \prime} \times 19^{\prime \prime}$ strips from remaining brown border; sew ends of strips together. Subcut (2) $1^{\prime \prime} \times 36-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips. |
| K | (2) $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips; subcut (8) $3-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares (cup \#3), <br> (8) $1-3 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 4^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles (cup \#1), (24) 1-1/4" $\times 1-3 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ (handles \#2, \#3 and \#4). |

## ADDITIONAL MATERIALS

2-3/4 yards backing fabric
Thread to match fabrics
Sewing machine

50" $\times 63^{\prime \prime}$ batting
Paper to print paper piecing patterns Basic sewing supplies

## CUP BLOCK

1. Paper piece the shapes on the cup pattern in numerical order using $\mathbf{F}, \mathbf{H}$ and $\mathbf{K}$ fabric pieces. Make 8.
2. Paper piece the shapes on the handle pattern in numerical order using $\mathbf{H}$ and $\mathbf{K}$ fabric pieces. Make 8.
3. Carefully remove paper from pieced cup and handle. Sew cup and handle together.

## HEART BLOCK

4. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of fabric G 2-3/4" squares and 1-1/4" squares. Make the number indicated.

5. Place (1) fabric G 2-3/4" square right side down on one lower corner of (1) fabric A 4-1/4" $\times 5^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle. Sew along the drawn line. Trim the stitching to $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ as indicated by the solid line. Press the $\mathbf{G}$ piece open.
6. Sew (1) fabric G 2-3/4" square to the other lower corner of the fabric $\mathbf{A} 4-1 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 5^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle, trim and press in the same manner to make lower heart unit. Unit should measure 4-1/4" $\times 5^{\prime \prime}$ including seam allowance. Make 4.

7. Place (1) fabric G 1-1/4" square right side down on one end of (1) fabric A 1-1/4" $\times 2-3 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle. Sew along the drawn line. Trim the stitching to $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ as indicated by the solid line. Press the $\mathbf{G}$ piece open.
8. Sew (1) fabric G 1-1/4" square to the other end of the $\mathbf{A}$ rectangle, trim and press in the same manner to make rectangle unit. Unit should measure 1-1/4" x 2-3/4" including seam allowance. Make 8.
9. Sew (2) rectangle units together to make upper heart unit.

## PATCHWORK BORDERS

11. Arrange (2) cup blocks, (3) C $5^{\prime \prime}$ squares, (3) E $5^{\prime \prime}$ squares and (1) G

Side border
Make 2 5" squares to make the side borders. Sew them together using generous $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam allowances so side borders measure $5^{\prime \prime} \times 40-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ including seam allowances. Make 2.

12. Arrange (2) cup blocks, (2) C $5^{\prime \prime}$ squares and (2) E $5^{\prime \prime}$ squares to make the top and bottom border. Sew them together using scant $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam allowance so borders measure $5^{\prime \prime} \times 28-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ including seam allowance. Sew (1) heart block to the ends of each border. Border should measure $5^{\prime \prime} \times 37-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ including seam allowance. Make 2.

## QUILT ASSEMBLY

13. Following the quilt layout on page 5 , sew (1) J 1 " $\times 36-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips to each side of $24 " \times 36-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ J Panel.
14. Sew (1) D $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 36-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ border to each side of center. Sew (2) F $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares to ends of $\mathbf{D} 2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 24-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ borders. Sew to top and bottom of quilt.
15. Sew (1) patchwork side border to each side of quilt. Sew (1) top and bottom patchwork border to top and bottom of quilt.
16. Sew (1) I $1^{\prime \prime} \times 49-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ border to side of quilt. Sew (1) I $1^{\prime \prime} \times 38-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ borders to top and bottom of quilt.
17. Sew (1) B 2-1/2" $\times 50-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ border to each side of quilt. Sew (1) B 2-1/2" $x$ 42-1/2" border to top and bottom of quilt.

## THE PERFECT CUP



FINISHING: Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich. Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using five fabric H 2-1/4" strips.
