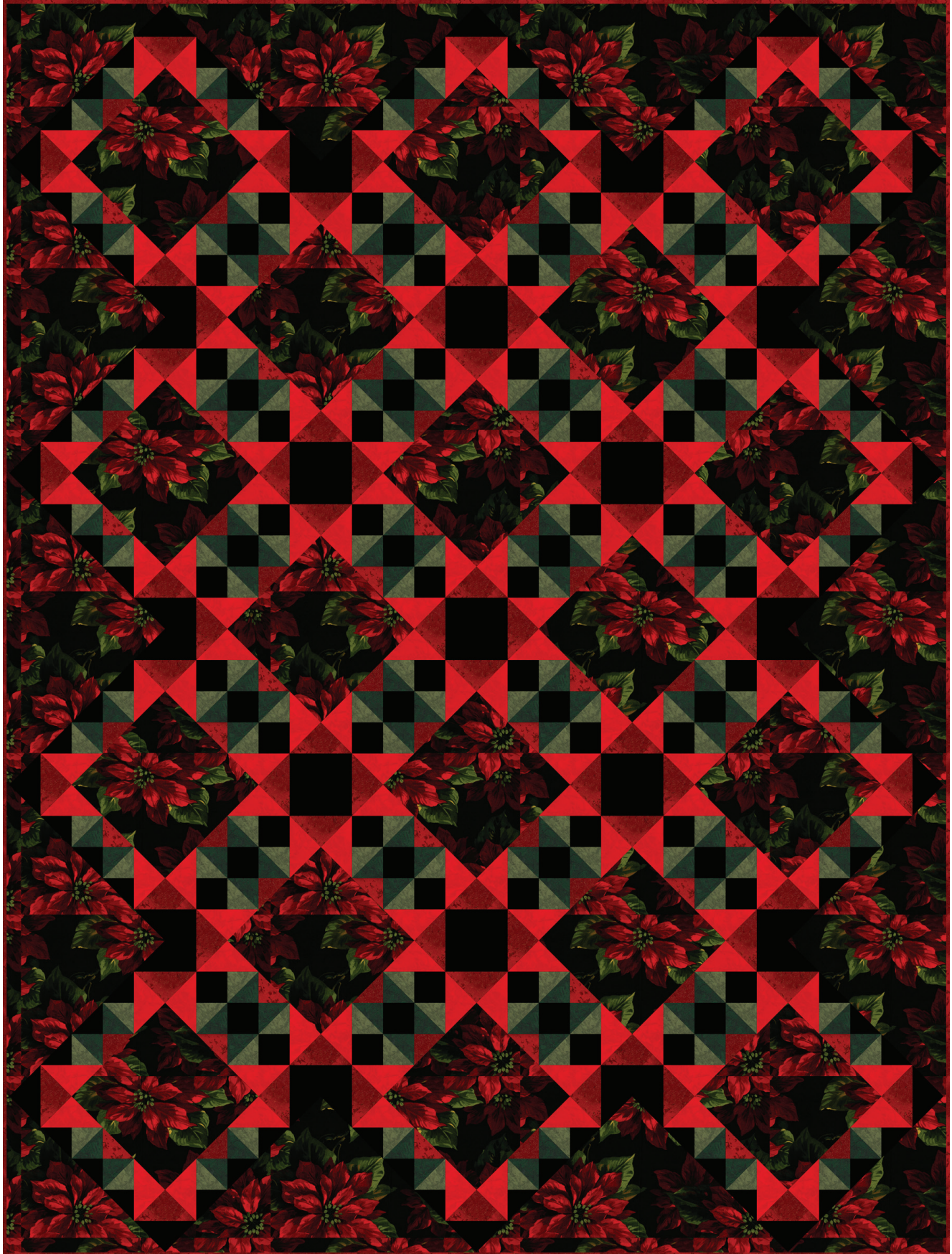

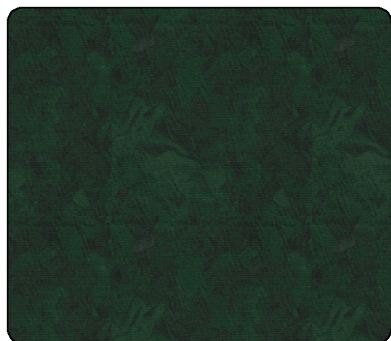

Backing & Batting: 72" x 93"



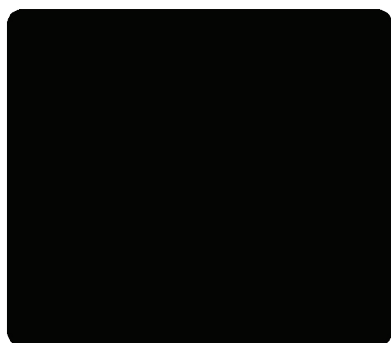

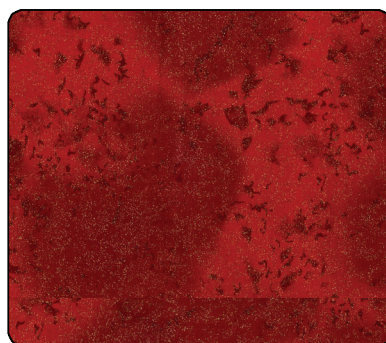

## "Grand Holiday"

Size: Approximately 64" x 85" Skill Level: Intermediate

### Materials

#### Cutting instructions

**Please Note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge.**

	Fabric	Yardage	Cutting
(A)	CJ3059 - Black Scarlet Poinsettia	3 ¼ yards	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Cut three 22 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into three 22 ½" squares and two 11 ½" squares. Cut the three 22 ½" squares across both diagonals to make twelve side setting triangles (You will only use ten triangles.) Cut the two 11 ½" squares across one diagonal to make four corner setting triangles.</li> <li>• Cut five 9 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into eighteen 9 ½" squares.</li> </ul>
(B)	K2257 - Krystal	⅔ yard	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Cut four 4 ¼" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into thirty-six 4 ¼" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (144) small triangles.</li> </ul>
(C)	K1156 - Krystal	⅔ yard	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Cut four 4 ¼" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into thirty-six 4 ¼" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (144) small triangles.</li> </ul>
(D)	K1149 - Krystal	1 yard	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Cut eight 3 ⅞" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into seventy-two 3 ⅞" squares. Cut the squares across one diagonal to make 144 medium triangles.</li> </ul>
(E)	Jet Black	1 ¼ yards	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Cut four 3 ⅞" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into thirty-six 3 ⅞" squares.</li> <li>• Cut six 4 ¼" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into fifty-four 4 ¼" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (216) small triangles.</li> </ul>
(F)	CM0376 - Holly Berry Fairy Frost	1 ⅓ yards	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Cut four 3 ⅞" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into thirty-six 3 ⅞" squares.</li> <li>• Cut two 4 ¼" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into eighteen 4 ¼" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make seventy-two small triangles.</li> <li>• Cut eight 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.</li> </ul>
Backing	CJ3059 - Black Scarlet Poinsettia	5 ½ yards	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Cut two 72" x WOF strips. Piece the strips together and trim to make the 72" x 93" pieced backing.</li> </ul>

#### You will also need:

- 72" x 93" batting, threads to match, scissors, straight pins, acrylic ruler, rotary cutter and mat.

Yardage requirements for this pattern may allow for excess yardage to accommodate specific placement of motifs or to allow for any fussy-cutting to achieve the finished quilt design.

While every attempt has been made to give accurate measurements, yardage requirements and construction directions; this does not allow personal variations in measuring, cutting or sewing. The enclosed directions were used in the construction of the original quilt.

## Block Assembly

1. Place one  $3\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric E square on top of one  $3\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric F square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Fig. 1). Sew  $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 1). Cut the two squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 2) to make two E/F units (Fig. 3). Trim E/F units to measure  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " square. Repeat to make seventy-two E/F units total.
2. Sew together one D triangle, one E triangle and one C triangle to make one Left D/E/C unit (Fig. 4). Repeat to make seventy-two Left D/E/C units.
3. Follow Figure 5 and repeat Step 2 to make seventy-two Right D/E/C units.
4. Sew together two Fabric B triangles, one Fabric F triangle and one Fabric E triangle to make one B/F/E unit. Repeat to make seventy-two B/F/E units.
5. Sew together one Left D/E/C unit, one B/F/E unit and one Right D/E/C unit to make one Border Block (Fig. 6). Repeat to make seventy-two block borders.
6. Sew one Border Block to each side of one  $9\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A square. Sew one E/F unit to each end of one Border Block for the top border. Repeat to make the bottom border. Sew the borders to the top and bottom of the  $9\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A square to make Block One (Fig. 7). Repeat to make eighteen Block Ones total.

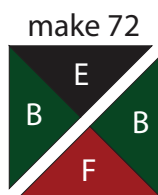

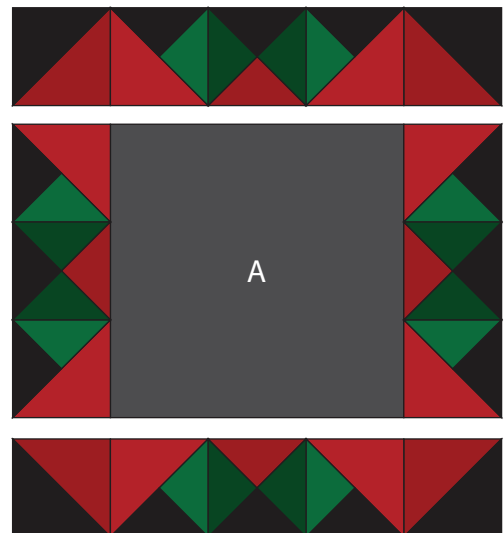
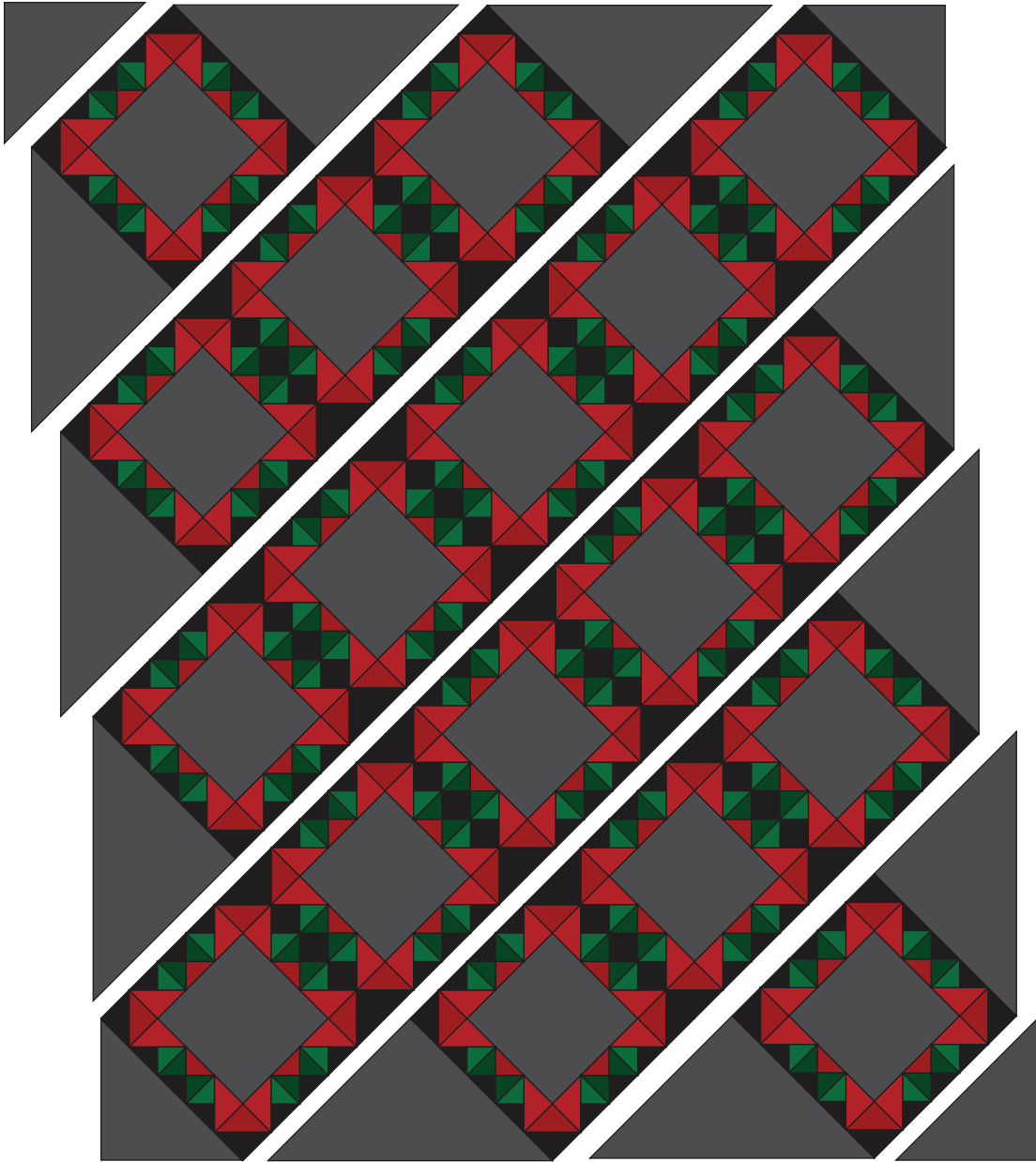

**Quilt Top Assembly (Follow Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)**

7. Follow the quilt layout to sew the blocks, corner triangles and side triangles together into diagonal rows. Sew the rows together to make the quilt top.
8. Layer and quilt as desired.
9. Sew the eight 2 ½" x WOF Fabric F strips together, end-to-end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press
10. Bind as desired.
