## ADDITIONAL MATERIALS

3-3/4 yards backing fabric
Thread to match fabrics

## APPLIQUÉ BLOCKS

1. Using your favorite appliqué method, prepare the appliqué pieces. See Note on Page 8.
2. Sew (1) C $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 11^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle to lower edge of (1) $\mathbf{L} 9^{\prime \prime} \times 11^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle. Background should measure $11^{\prime \prime}$ square including seam allowance. Place (1) $\mathbf{F}$ Birdhouse1 on background centered $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ from lower edge.
3. Place (1) M Roof 1A overlapping upper right edge of birdhouse. Place (1) M Roof 1B overlapping upper left edge of birdhouse and Roof 1A. Place (1) M Base 1 along bottom of background overlapping lower edge of birdhouse. Position (1) D Circle on birdhouse.
4. Pin or fuse pieces in place. Sew around edges of appliqué pieces. Make 2.

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5. Sew (1) $\mathbf{H} 3^{\prime \prime} \times 11^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle to lower edge of (1) $\mathbf{L} 8-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 11^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle. Background should measure $11^{\prime \prime}$ square including seam allowance. Place (1) M Birdhouse 2 on background centered $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ from lower edge.
6. Place (1) E Roof 2A overlapping upper right edge of birdhouse. Place (1) E Roof 2B overlapping upper left edge of birdhouse and Roof 2A. Place (1) E Base 1 along bottom of background overlapping lower edge of birdhouse. Position (1) ECircle on birdhouse.
7. Pin or fuse pieces in place. Sew around edges of appliqué pieces. Make 1.
8. Following steps 6-7 make a second Birdhouse 2 using the fabrics indicated. Make 1.

9. Sew (1) D $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 11^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle to lower edge of (1) $\mathbf{L} 10^{\prime \prime} \times 11^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle. Background should measure $11^{\prime \prime}$ square including seam allowance. Place (1) J Post centered on lower edge of block. Place (1) B Birdhouse 3 on background centered 2" from lower edge.
10. Place (1) J Roof 3A overlapping upper right edge of birdhouse. Place (1) J Roof 3B overlapping upper left edge of birdhouse and Roof 3A. Place (1) M door centered on lower edge of birdhouse. Place (1) E Base 3 along bottom of birdhouse overlapping upper edge of the post. Position (1) M Heart on birdhouse.
11. Pin or fuse pieces in place. Sew around edges of appliqué pieces. Make 2.

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## PATCHWORK BLOCKS

12. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of each $\mathbf{N} 2-3 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ square.

13. Place (1) $\mathbf{N} 2-3 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ square and (1) $\mathbf{F} 2-3 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ square together with right sides in. Reverse $\mathbf{N}$ square for (2) pairs. Sew $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ on each side of diagonal line. Cut along the diagonal line to make 4 F/N half square triangle (HST) units. Make 2 each.
15. Sew rectangle units together to make a $F / K / N$ square unit. Square should measure 4 " square including seam allowance. Make 4. Note orientation of fabric F.
16. Sew (1) D 4-3/4" triangle to (1) $\mathbf{N} 4-3 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ triangle to make a triangle pair unit. Make 2.
17. Sew (2) triangle pair units together to make a $\mathbf{D} / \mathbf{N}$ square unit. Square should measure 4" square including seam allowance. Make 4.


14. Sew (1) F/N HST unit to (1) $\mathbf{N} 2-1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ square. Sew (1) F/N HST unit to (1) K 2-1/4" square. Make 1 each.

18. Arrange (4) $\mathbf{F} / \mathbf{K} / \mathbf{N}$ square units, $4 \mathbf{D} / \mathbf{N}$ square units and (1) A 4" square in 3 rows. Sew the units and square together in each row. Sew the rows together to make a block. Make 3.
19. Following steps 12-18, make (3) using the fabrics indicated.

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## ASSEMBLING THE QUILT

20. Following the Quilt Layout, sew together (4) I 1-3/4" $\times 11^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles alternating with (3) blocks to make the block rows. Make 4.
21. Sew together (4) F 1-3/4" squares alternating with (3) I $1-3 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 11^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles to make the sashing rows. Make 5.
22. Sew together (5) sashing rows alternating with (4) block rows to make the quilt center. Quilt center should measure 37 " x 48-3/4" including seam allowance.
23. Sew (1) A 3-3/4" $\times 48-3 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ border to each side of quilt center. Sew (1) A 3-3/4" $\times 43-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ border to each top and bottom of quilt.

FINISHING: Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich. Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using nine fabric F 2-1/4" strips.
