KEY	CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS				
Α	 (2) 3-3/4" x 48-3/4" LOF borders. (3) 3-3/4" x 34" WOF strips; sew short ends together. Subcut (2) 3-3/4" x 43-1/2" borders. (6) 4" squares fussy-cut over bird motifs. 				
В	(2) birdhouse 3 patterns.				
С	(1) 2-1/2" x 42"strip; subcut (2) 2-1/2" x 11" rectangles.				
D	 (1) 4-3/4" x 42" strip; subcut (6) 4-3/4" squares. Cut in half diagonally twice to make 24 triangles. (1) 2-3/4" x 42" strip; subcut (12) 2-3/4" squares. (2) circle patterns. (2) 1-1/2" x 11" rectangle. 				
Е	(1) birdhouse 2 pattern. (1) roof pattern 2A and 2B. (1) circle pattern. (1) base 1 and 2 pattern.				
F	(2) birdhouse 1 patterns. (1) 2-3/4" x 36" strip; subcut (12) 2-3/4" squares. (1) 1-3/4" strip; subcut (20) 1-3/4" squares. FOR BINDING: (5) 2-1/4" x 42" strips, sew short ends together.				
G	(1) 4-3/4" x 42" strip; subcut (6) 4-3/4" squares. Cut in half diagonally twice to make 24 triangles.				
Н	(1) 3" x 42" strip; subcut (2) 3" x 11" rectangles.				
I	(1) 11" x 42" strip; subcut (24) 1-3/4" x 11" rectangles. (3) 1-3/4" x 42" strips; subcut (7) 1-3/4" x 11" rectangles.				
J	(2) roof 3A and 3B patterns. (2) base 3 patterns. (2) post patterns.				
K	(2) 2-1/4" x 42" strips; subcut (24) 2-1/4" squares.				



KEY	CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS	
L	(1) 9" x 42" strip; subcut (2) 9" x 11" and (1) 8-1/2" x 11". (1) 10" x 42" strip; subcut (2) 10" x 11" and (1) 8-1/2" x 11".	
M	(1) birdhouse 2 pattern. (2) roof 1A and 1B patterns. (1) roof 2A and 2B patterns. (2) door patterns. (2) heart patterns. (3) base 1 and 2. (1) circle.	
N	 (2) 4-3/4" x 42" strip; subcut (12) 4-3/4" squares. Cut in half diagonally twice to make 48 triangles. (2) 2-1/4" x 42" strips; subcut (24) 2-1/4" squares. (2) 2-3/4" x 42"; subcut (24) 2-3/4" squares. 	

ADDITIONAL MATERIALS

3-3/4 yards backing fabric 52" x 64" batting Thread to match fabrics Sewing machine

Basic sewing supplies Rotary cutter, ruler and mat

Optional:

For turned under edge appliqué: freezer paper or other template paper.

For raw edge appliqué: paper backed fusible webbing.

APPLIQUÉ BLOCKS

- 1. Using your favorite appliqué method, prepare the appliqué pieces. See Note on Page 8.
- **2.** Sew (1) **C** 2-1/2" \times 11" rectangle to lower edge of (1) **L** 9" \times 11" rectangle. Background should measure 11" square including seam allowance. Place (1) **F** Birdhouse1 on background centered 1/2" from lower edge.
- **3.** Place (1) **M** Roof 1A overlapping upper right edge of birdhouse. Place (1) **M** Roof 1B overlapping upper left edge of birdhouse and Roof 1A. Place (1) **M** Base 1 along bottom of background overlapping lower edge of birdhouse. Position (1) **D** Circle on birdhouse.
- 4. Pin or fuse pieces in place. Sew around edges of appliqué pieces. Make 2.




- **5.** Sew (1) **H** 3" \times 11" rectangle to lower edge of (1) **L** 8-1/2" \times 11" rectangle. Background should measure 11" square including seam allowance. Place (1) **M** Birdhouse 2 on background centered 1/2" from lower edge.
- **6.** Place (1) **E** Roof 2A overlapping upper right edge of birdhouse. Place (1) **E** Roof 2B overlapping upper left edge of birdhouse and Roof 2A. Place (1) **E** Base 1 along bottom of background overlapping lower edge of birdhouse. Position (1) **E** Circle on birdhouse.
- 7. Pin or fuse pieces in place. Sew around edges of appliqué pieces. Make 1.
- 8. Following steps 6-7 make a second Birdhouse 2 using the fabrics indicated. Make 1.





Make 1

- **9.** Sew (1) **D** 1-1/2" x 11" rectangle to lower edge of (1) **L** 10" x 11" rectangle. Background should measure 11" square including seam allowance. Place (1) **J** Post centered on lower edge of block. Place (1) **B** Birdhouse 3 on background centered 2" from lower edge.
- **10.** Place (1) **J** Roof 3A overlapping upper right edge of birdhouse. Place (1) **J** Roof 3B overlapping upper left edge of birdhouse and Roof 3A. Place (1) **M** door centered on lower edge of birdhouse. Place (1) **E** Base 3 along bottom of birdhouse overlapping upper edge of the post. Position (1) **M** Heart on birdhouse.
- **11.** Pin or fuse pieces in place. Sew around edges of appliqué pieces. Make 2.








PATCHWORK BLOCKS

12. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of each **N** 2-3/4" square.

15. Sew rectangle units together to make a F/K/N square unit. Square should measure 4" square including seam allowance. Make 4. Note orientation of fabric \mathbf{F} .













16. Sew (1) **D** 4-3/4" triangle to (1) **N** 4-3/4" triangle to make a triangle pair unit. Make 2.







18. Arrange (4) **F/K/N** square units, 4 **D/N** square units and (1) **A** 4" square in 3 rows. Sew the units and square together in each row. Sew the rows together to make a block. Make 3.

19. Following steps 12-18, make (3) using the fabrics indicated.







ASSEMBLING THE QUILT

- **20.** Following the Quilt Layout, sew together (4) I 1-3/4" x 11" rectangles alternating with (3) blocks to make the block rows. Make 4.
- **21.** Sew together (4) **F** 1-3/4" squares alternating with (3) **I** 1-3/4" x 11" rectangles to make the sashing rows. Make 5.
- **22.** Sew together (5) sashing rows alternating with (4) block rows to make the quilt center. Quilt center should measure 37" x 48-3/4" including seam allowance.
- **23.** Sew (1) \mathbf{A} 3-3/4" x 48-3/4" border to each side of quilt center. Sew (1) \mathbf{A} 3-3/4" x 43-1/2" border to each top and bottom of quilt.


FINISHING: Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich. Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using nine fabric **F** 2-1/4" strips.




