KEY	CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS
Α	(3) 3-1/2" X 42" strips; subcut (30) 3-1/2" squares. (72) Petal templates fussy-cut over girl motifs, if desired.
В	(6) Center templates.
С	(6) Center templates.
D	(36) Petal templates. (15) Large Circle templates.
Е	(5) 1-3/4" x 42" strips, sew short ends together. Subcut (2) 1-3/4" x 54" borders and (2) 1-3/4" x 45" borders. (36) Petal templates.
F	(8) 2" x 42" strips; subcut (31) 2" x 10-1/2" strips.
G	(2) 7-1/2" x 59-3/4" strips, fussy-cut over border. Trim ends diagonally. (2) 7-1/2" x 71-1/4" strips, fussy-cut over border. Trim ends diagonally.
Н	(4) 10-1/2" x 42" strips; subcut (12) 10-1/2" squares. (3) 3-1/2" X 42" strips; subcut (30) 3-1/2" squares. (1) 2" x 42" strip; subcut (20) 2" squares.
I	FOR BINDING: (7) 2-1/4" x 42" strips, sew short ends together. (15) Large Circle templates. (20) Small Circle templates.
	Batting 67" x 79"
	Backing 4-1/2 yards; piece a 67" x 79" rectangle.

ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS

Thread to match fabrics Basic sewing supplies Template plastic Sewing machine Rotary cutter, ruler and mat

Optional:

For turned under edge appliqué: freezer paper or other template paper. For raw edge appliqué: paper backed fusible webbing.




BLOCKS

For Turned Edge Appliqué:


- **1.** Arrange (6) **A** Petals, (3) **D** Petals and (3) **E** Petals as shown. Sew (2) Petals together along the long straight edges beginning the stitching at the corner of the seamline.
- **2.** Join (12) Petals to form a ring in the same manner. Press under the seam allowance along the outer straight edges of the petals.

3. Center a paper template on (1) **B** Center. Fold the edge of the fabric over the edge of the paper template. Baste or press in place.



For Raw Edge Appliqué:

- **1.** Arrange (6) **A** Petals, (3) **D** Petals and (3) **E** Petals as shown. Fuse narrow strips of paper backed fusible webbing to the short outer edges. Sew (2) Petals together along the long straight edges.
- 2. Join (12) Petals to form a ring unit.
- 3. Fuse (1) paper-backed fusible webbing ring to the edge of (1) B Center.






For Both Applique Methods:

4. Pin or fuse the petal ring unit centered on (1) **H** 10-1/2" square. Sew the outer edges in place using your preferred method.

- **5.** Pin or fuse the **B** Center centered on the petal ring. Sew along the outer edge using your preferred method.
- **6.** Followng steps 1-5, make blocks using a **C** Center. Note positions of fabrics **D** and **E**.

Appliqué Sashing Squares

7. Following step 3 for your preferred method, prepare (20) I Small Circle appliqués. Pin or fuse (1) I Small Circle on each **H** 2" square. Sew around the edge. Make 20.



Appliqué Borders

8. Following step 3 for your preferred method, prepare (16) **D** Large Circle appliqués. Pin or fuse (1) **I** Large Circle on each **H** 3-1/2" square. Sew around the edge to make a circle unit. Make 15.







9. Following step 8, make (16) circle units using I Large Circles. Make 15.

Make 16 each

10. Sew together (7) \mathbf{A} 3-1/2" squares alternating with 7 circle units as shown to make the top and bottom borders. Borders should measure 3-1/2" x 42-1/2" including seam allowance. Make 1 each.




11. Sew together (8) \mathbf{A} 3-1/2" squares alternating with 8 circle units as shown to make the side borders. Use a slightly generous seam allowance so border measures 3-1/2" x 48" including seam allowances. Make 1 each.





QUILT ASSEMBLY

12. Arrange blocks in rows of 3 blocks each alternating the $\bf C$ and $\bf D$ centers as shown. Sew together (4) $\bf F$ 2" x 10-1/2" strips alternating with (3) blocks to make the block rows 1 and 2. Make 2 each.



13. Sew together (5) **H/I** 2" sashing squares alternating with (4) **F** 2" \times 10-1/2" strips to make the sashing rows. Make 5.



14. Following the Quilt Layout on page 6, sew together (5) sashing rows and (4) block rows to make the quilt center.

BORDERS

- **15.** Sew the patchwork side borders to the sides of the quilt. Sew the patchwork top and bottom borders to the top and bottom of quilt.
- **16.** Sew (1) **E** 1-3/4" x 54" border to each side of quilt. Sew (1) **E** 1-3/4" x 45" border to top and bottom of quilt.
- **17.** Sew shorter straight edge of (1) \mathbf{G} 7" x 71-1/4" border to sides of quilt beginning and ending stitching 1/4" from the edges of the quilt. Sew shorter straight edge of (1) \mathbf{G} 7" x 59-3/4" border to top and bottom of quilt beginning and ending 1/4" from the edges of the quilt. Sew diagonal ends of adjacent borders together.

FINISHING: Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich. Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using seven fabric I 2-1/4" strips.
