



Α	(3) 11-1/2" x 40-1/2" strips.
В	(2) 3-3/4" x 40-1/2" strips. (18) Half Circle templates. (4) 2-3/4" squares.
С	(6) 3" x 42" strips; sew short ends together. Subcut (2) 3" x 59-1/2" borders and (2) 3" x 48-1/2" borders.
D	 (5) 2" x 42" strips; sew short ends together. Subcut (2) 2" x 56-1/2" borders and (2) 2" x 40-1/2" borders. (20) Half Circle templates.
Е	(2) Wave Templates. (See Wave Appliqué Template instructions on page 3.)
F	(6) Fish Templates. (4) Eye Templates. (Alternatively, eyes can be embroidered using orange thread.)
G	 (4) Fish Templates. (6) Eye Templates. (Alternatively, eyes can be embroidered using navy thread.) (2) Wave Templates. (See Wave Appliqué Template instructions on page 3.) (6) 2-3/4" x 42" strips; sew short ends together. Subcut (2) 2-3/4" x 64-1/2" borders and (2) 2-3/4" x 48-1/2" borders. FOR BINDING: (7) 2-1/4" x 42" strips, sew short ends together.

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

ADDITIONAL MATERIALS

Thread to match fabrics Basic sewing supplies **For raw edge appliqué:** fusible webbing or fabric glue stick **For turned edge appliqué:** freezer paper

WAVE APPLIQUÉ TEMPLATE

Make 4 copies of page 8. Cut out the templates. Cut along the dashed seamline to trim the left end seam allowances from 3 pattern pieces. Line up the pieces as shown below. Overlap the patterns matching the side seamlines; glue or tape patterns together. If using a raw edge appliqué method, trim seam allowance from top and bottom edges after marking fabric in steps 1-2.



HORIZONTAL STRIPS

1. Place the Wave Template along the top edge of (1) **A** 11-1/2" X 40-1/2" strip and trace along the top edge. Move the Wave Template to the bottom edge of the strip and trace along the bottom edge of the strip.




2. Cut along the curved lines. Mark the top and bottom seamline 1/4" from the top and bottom edges to make (1) **A** horizontal section. Make 3.





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3. Following steps 1-2, make curved edges along the top and bottom of (2) **H** 8-1/4" x 40-1/2" strips, (1) **I** 6-1/4" x 40-1/2" strip and (2) **K** 6-1/4" x 40-1/2" strips to make horizontal sections.



4. Following steps 1-2, mark 1 curved edge along the top edge only of (2) **B** 3-3/4" x 40-1/2" to make top and bottom horizontal sections. Make 2.






5. Prepare (6) **F** Fish appliqués and (4) **G** Fish appliqués using your preferred method. Prepare (6) **G** Eye appliqués and (4) **F** Eye appliqués, if you prefer to appliqué the eyes.

6. Place (1) **F** Fish appliqué in the center of (1) **H** horizontal section. Place (2) **F** Fish appliqués approximately 1-3/4" from ends as shown. Place (2) **G** Fish appliqués centered between the **F** Fish appliqués. Fuse or pin Fish in place. Sew along the edges.

7. Fuse or pin **F** and **G** Eyes in place on each Fish. Sew along the edges. Or, embroider eyes, if desired.





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QUILT CENTER

8. Beginning in the center of the quilt, overlap top edge of (1) **A** horizontal section with (1) **I** horizontal section 1/2" matching seamlines. Topstitch sections together along seamline.



9. Prepare the top and bottom edges of (2) **E**, (2) **G**, (3) **J** and (2) **I** Wave appliqués using your preferred method.

10. Place (1) **E** Wave appliqué centered over the seamline. Fuse or pin in place. Sew along the top and bottom edges.



11. Following the quilt layout on page 7, continue adding horizontal sections and sewing Wave appliqués in place working from the center to the top. Then, complete the quilt center working from the center to the bottom. Quilt center should measure 40-1/2" x 56-1/2" including seam allowance. Trim top and bottom edges evenly, if needed.

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
APPLIQUÉ BORDER

12. Prepare the curved edge of (18) **B**, (20) **D** and (18) **K** Half Circle appliqués using your preferred method.

13. Draw a line 1/4" from the left end of (1) **G** $2-3/4" \times 48-1/2"$ border. Draw a line 4" from the first line. Repeat 11 more times ending 1/4" from the right end. Make 2.



14. Fuse or baste the **B**, **D** and **K** Half Circle appliqués on (2) **G** 2-3/4" x 48-1/2 borders as shown. Sew Half Circle appliqués in place using your preferred appliqué method to make top and bottom borders. Make 2.

15. Following steps 13-14, make side borders using (1) **G** 2-3/4" x 64-1/2" borders. Mark lines 1/4" from ends and 15 lines between spaced 4" apart. Fuse or baste the **D**, **K** and **B** Half Circle appliqués as shown. Sew in place using your preferred appliqué method to make side borders. Make 2.



16. Sew (1) $D 2'' \times 56-1/2''$ border to each side of quilt center. Sew (1) K 2'' square to ends of each $D 2'' \times 40-1/2''$ border. Sew to top and bottom of quilt.

17. Sew (1) **C** $3'' \times 59-1/2''$ border to each side of quilt center. Sew (1) **C** $3'' \times 48-1/2''$ to top and bottom of quilt.

18. Sew (1) side applique border to each side of quilt. Sew (2) **B** 2-3/4" squares to ends of top and bottom applique borders. Sew to top and bottom of quilt.

FINISHING: Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich. Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using seven fabric **G** 2-1/4" strips.



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
