

KEY	CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS
Α	(1) 3" x 42" strip: subcut (14) 3" squares.
В	(5) 2" x 42" strips centered over rows of vehicles; subcut (2) 2" x 40" strips and (14) 2" x 7" rectangles.
С	(2) 1-3/4" x 42" strips; subcut (16) 1-3/4" x 3" rectangles and (16) 1-3/4" squares. (2) 1-1/2" x 42" strips; subcut (2) 1-1/2" x 40" strips.
D	(5) 2-1/2" x 42" strips; sew ends together. Subcut (2) 2-1/2" x 53" borders and (2) 2-1/2" x 44" borders.  (4) 1-3/4" x 42" strips; sew ends together. Subcut (2) 1-3/4" x 43-1/2" borders and (2) 1-3/4" x 27" borders.
E	(2) 1-1/2" x 42" strips; subcut (2) 1-1/2" x 40" strips. (1) 2" x 42" strip; subcut (6) 2" x 5-1/2" rectangles.
F	(2) 1-3/4" x 42" strips; subcut (16) 1-3/4" x 3" rectangles and (16) 1-3/4" squares. <b>FOR BINDING:</b> (5) 2-1/4" x 42" strips, sew short ends together.
G	(2) 1-3/4" x 42" strips; subcut (12) 1-3/4" x 3" rectangles and (12) 1-3/4" squares.
Н	(2) 2" x 42" strips; subcut (8) 2" x 5-1/2" rectangles.
ı	(1) 24-1/2" x 43-1/2" rectangle centered over panel.
J	(2) 1-3/4" x 42" strips; subcut (12) 1-3/4" x 3" rectangles and (12) 1-3/4" squares.
K	(5) 1-3/4" x 42" strips, subcut (112) 1-3/4" squares.

### **ADDITIONAL MATERIALS**

2-3/4 yards 45" wide backing fabric Thread to match fabrics Sewing machine Rotary cutter, ruler and mat Basic sewing supplies




#### **BLOCKS**

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (112) K 1-3/4" squares.



**2.** Lay (1) **K** 1-3/4" square on one end of (1) **F** 1-3/4" x 3" rectangle. Sew along the drawn line. Trim the fabric 1/4" from the stitching as indicated by the solid line. Press the **K** piece open.





**3**. Sew (1) **K** 1-3/4" square to the other end of the **F** rectangle, trim and press in the same manner to make a flying geese unit. Unit should measure 1-3/4" x 3" including seam allowance. Make 4.





**4.** Sew (2) **F** 1-3/4" squares to ends of (2) flying geese units to make top and bottom units. Make 2.



**5.** Sew (2) flying geese units to sides of (1) **A** 3" square to make center unit. Make 1.



**6.** Sew top and bottom units to center unit matching seams to make (1) star block. Make 4.



**7.** Repeat steps 2-6 using **C, G and J** 1-3/4" x 3" rectangles and 1-3/4" squares. Make the number indicated.


**8.** Sew (1) **H** 2"  $\times$  5-`1/2" rectangle to the right side of (2) **F** star blocks. Sew (1) **H** 2"  $\times$  5-1/2" rectangle to the left side of (2) **F** star blocks. Sew (1) **B** 2"  $\times$  7" rectangle to the lower edge. Make 2 each.








**9.** Repeat step 8, using **C** star blocks. Make 2 each.









**10.** Repeat step 8, using **G** and **J** star blocks, **E**  $2'' \times 5-1/2''$  rectangles and **B**  $2'' \times 7''$  rectangles. Make the number indicated.

#### **TOP AND BOTTOM BORDERS**

- **11.** Sew (1) **C** 1-1/2"  $\times$  40" to the upper edge of (1) **B** 2"  $\times$  40" strip. Sew (1) **E** 1-1/2"  $\times$  40" to the lower edge of the **B** 2"  $\times$  40" strip to make the top border. Make 1.
- **12.** Sew (1) **E** 1-1/2"  $\times$  40" to the upper edge of (1) **B** 2"  $\times$  40" strip. Sew (1) **C** 1-1/2"  $\times$  40" to the lower edge of the **B** 2"  $\times$  40" strip to make the bottom border. Make 1.




#### SIDE BORDERS

**13.** Arrange the star blocks in 2 rows of 7 blocks each as shown. Note the fabric in each star block and the orientation of the **E** and **H** strips. Sew the blocks in each row together to make the side borders. Make 1 each.

#### **QUILT ASSEMBLY**

- **14.** Following the layout diagram on page 6, sew (1) **D** 1-3/4" x 43-1/2" border to each side of **I** 24-1/2" x 43-1/2" panel. Sew (1) **D** 1-3/4" x 27" border to top and bottom of quilt.
- **15.** Sew (1) side border to each side of quilt noting orientation of borders.
- 16. Sew top and bottom borders to quilt.
- **17.** Sew (1) **D** 2-1/2" x 53" border to each side of quilt. Sew (1) **D** 2-1/2" x 44" border to top and bottom of quilt.

**FINISHING:** Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich. Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using five fabric **F** 2-1/4" strips.
