


Note: Mark the center of the curved edges by folding the piece in half and finger pressing the fold.

#### **KOI BLOCKS**

- **1.** Note orientation of fabric **A** Koi and fabric **D** scallops. Align the center of the inner curve of (1) **D** Corner Template and the curved edge of (1) **A** 1/4 Circle Template and then pin the centers together. Pin the ends together. Ease the curves along the seamline and pin about every 3/4".
- **2.** Carefully and slowly sew along the seamline. Press the seam toward the center. Block should measure 6-1/2" including seam allowance. Make 6.







**3.** Following Steps 1-2 make Units using **A** 1/4 Circle Templates, and **F** and **G** Corner Templates. Make the number of units indicated. Note orientation of fabric **A** Koi.






STRIP PIECED BLOCKS

**4.** Sew (1) **B** 1-3/4" x 42" strip and (1) **E** 1-3/4" x 42" strip together. Sew (1) **C** 2-1/2" strip to the **E** side of the joined strips to make a strip pieced unit. Make 3.



5. Cut (4) Triangle Templates from each strip pieced unit. Make 12.

**6.** Sew (1) strip pieced triangle to (1) **H** 6-7/8" triangle to make (1) strip pieced block. Block should measure 6-1/2" including seam allowance. Make 12.

#### **STRIP PIECED BORDER**

**7.** Sew (1) each **D, F, B, C, E** and **A** 2" x 42" together. Make 2.



**8.** Cut joined strips into 4" lengths to make strip units. Make 20.

**9.** Sew (5) strip units together. Remove (2) strips from end of (2) borders so each contains 28 strips and measures 4" x 42-1/2" including seam allowance. Sew (2) strips to beginning of side strip border and remove 4 end strips so each contains 28 strips and measures 4" x 42-1/2" including seam allowance. Make 2 each.

**10.** Sew together (1) **B** 4-3/8" triangle and (1) **H** 4-3/8" triangle together to make a corner square. Note orientation of print on **B** triangles. Make 4.

#### **QUILT ASSEMBLY**

- **11.** Following the Quilt Layout, arrange the Koi Blocks and the Strip Pieced Blocks in (6) rows of (6) blocks each. Note position of fabrics and orientation of blocks. Sew the blocks in each row together.
- **12.** Sew the rows together matching seams.

#### **BORDERS**

**13.** Sew (1)  $\mathbf{C}$  1-3/4" x 36-1/2" border to each side of quilt. Sew (2)  $\mathbf{C}$  1-3/4" x 39" borders to top and bottom of quilt.




- **14.** Sew (1)  $\mathbf{H}$  2-1/4" x 39" border to each side of quilt. Sew (2)  $\mathbf{H}$  2-1/4" x 42-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt.
- **15.** Sew (1) Strip Pieced Border to each side of quilt. Sew (2) Corner Squares to ends of (2) Strip Pieced Borders noting orientation of fabrics. Sew to top and bottom of quilt.



**FINISHING:** Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich. Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using five fabric **H** 2-1/4" strips.
