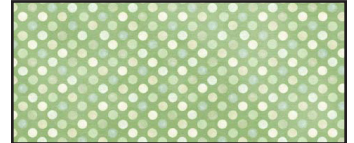

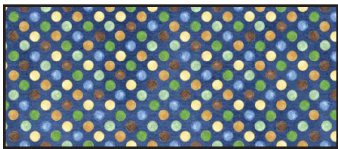

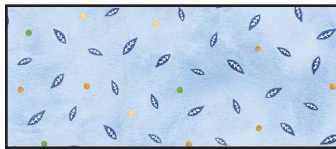

KEY	CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS
A	Centering avocado blocks, fussy cut: (8) 9-1/2" squares.
B	(2) Heart templates.
C	(5) 3-1/2" x 42" strips, sew short ends together. Subcut (2) 3-1/2" x 47" strips and (2) 3-1/2" x 41" strips.
D	(2) 2-5/8" x 42" strips.
E	(2) 2-5/8" x 42" strips.
F	(4) 1-1/2" x 42" strips; Subcut (2) 1-1/2" x 41" strips and (2) 1-1/2" x 39" strips.
G	(6) 1" x 42" strips.
H	(2) 2-5/8" x 42" strips.
I	(8) 1" x 42" strips, subcut (16) 1" x 10-1/2" strips and (16) 1" x 9-1/2" strips. (2) 5-1/2" squares.
J	(2) 2-5/8" x 42" strips.
K	(2) 5-1/2" squares.
L	(2) 2-5/8" x 42" strips; subcut (16) 2-5/8" squares. FOR BINDING: (5) 2-1/4" x 42" strips, sew short ends together.

ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS

Batting 55" x 55"

Thread to match fabrics

Basic sewing supplies

Rotary cutter, ruler and mat

2-1/2 yards backing fabric

Sewing machine

Template plastic

Optional:

For turned edge appliqué: freezer paper or other template paper.

For raw edge appliqué: paper backed fusible webbing.

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AVOCADO BLOCKS

1. Sew (1) **I** 1" x 9-1/2" strip to each side of (1) **A** 9-1/2" square. Sew (1) **I** 1" x 10-1/2" strip to top and bottom of square. Finished block should measure 10-1/2" x 10-1/2" including seam allowance. Make 8.

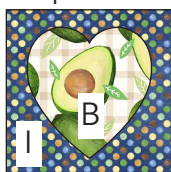
APPLIQUÉ BLOCK

2. Prepare (2) **B** Heart templates using your preferred appliqué method. Center Hearts on (2) **I** 5-1/2" squares. Sew Hearts in place along edge to complete appliqué square. Make 2.

3. Sew (1) appliqué square to top of (1) **K** 5-1/2" square. Sew (1) appliqué square to bottom of (1) **K** 5-1/2" square. Note orientation of hearts. Make 1 each.

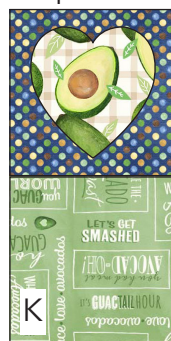
4. Sew (2) pairs of squares together to complete block. Note orientation of hearts. Finished block should measure 10-1/2" including seam allowance. Make 1.

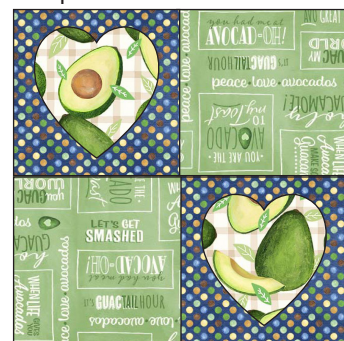

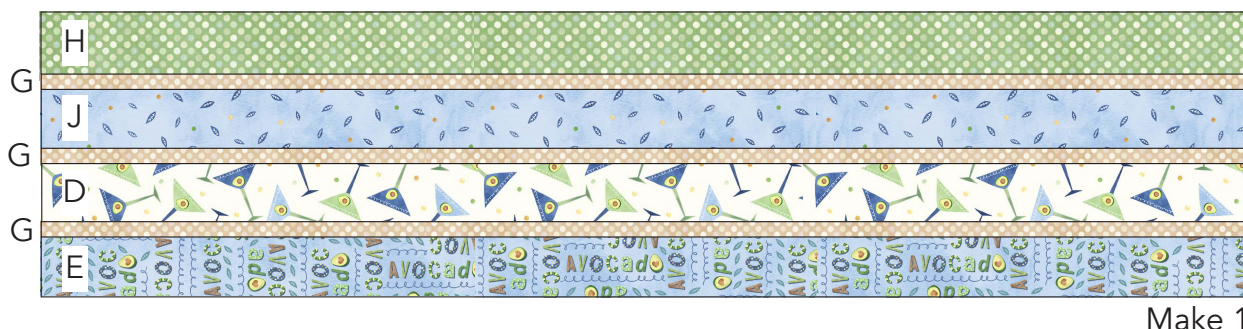
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STRIP PIECED SASHING

5. Sew together (1) **D** 2-5/8" x 42" strip, (1) **E** 2-5/8" x 42" strip, (1) **H** 2-5/8" x 42" strip and (1) **J** 2-5/8" x 42" strip alternating with (3) **G** 1" x 42" strips. Make 1.

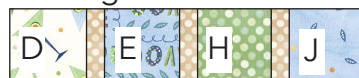


6. Following step 5, change the order of (4) 2-5/8" x 42" strips as shown. Make 1.



7. Cut joined strips into 2-5/8" widths to make sashing units 1 and 2. Sashing units should measure 2-5/8" x 10-1/2" including seam allowance. Make 12 each.

Sashing unit 1



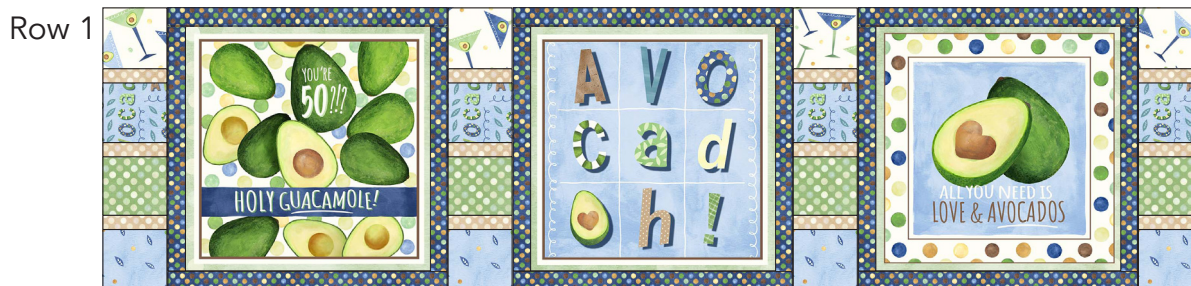

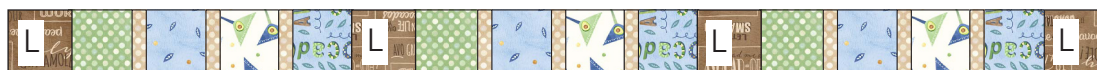

8. Following the Quilt Layout on page 5, arrange the Avocado Blocks and Appliqué Block in (3) rows of (3) blocks. Sew together (4) sashing unit 1 alternating with (3) blocks to make the block rows. Row 1 is shown. Make 3.



9. Sew together (4) **L** 2-5/8" squares alternating with (3) sashing unit 2 to make the sashing rows. Make 4.

10. Sew together (4) sashing rows alternating with (3) block rows to make the quilt center.

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BORDERS

11. Sew (1) **F** 1-1/2" x 39" strip to each side of quilt. Sew (1) **F** 1-1/2" x 41" strip to top and bottom of quilt.

12. Sew (1) **C** 3-1/2" x 41" strip to each side of quilt. Sew (1) **C** 3-1/2" x 47" strip to top and bottom of quilt.

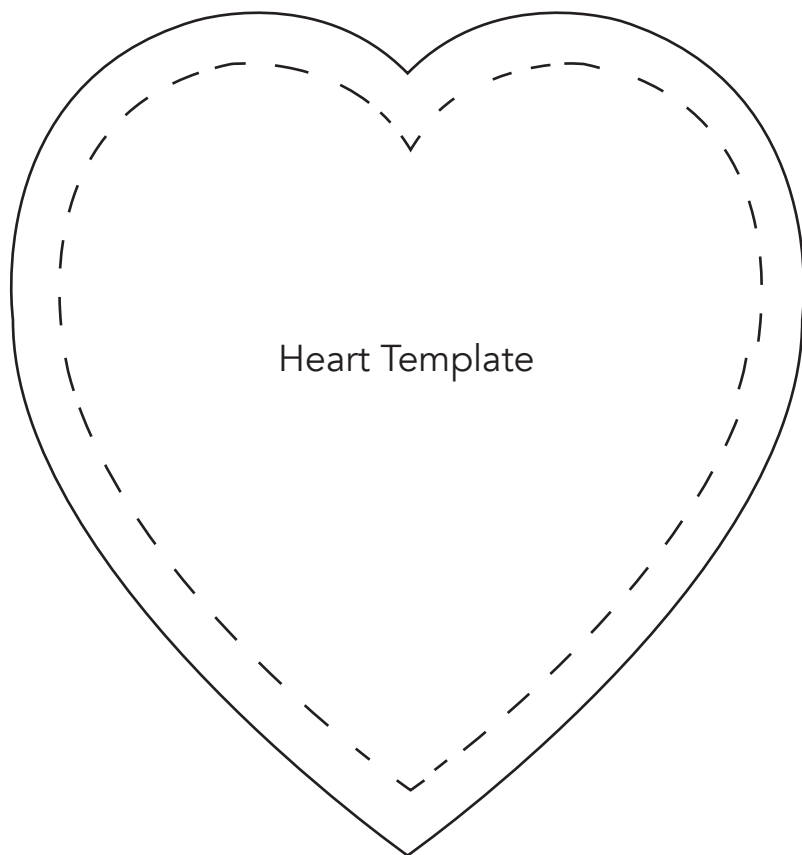
Quilt Layout



FINISHING: Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich. Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using five fabric **L** 2-1/4" strips.

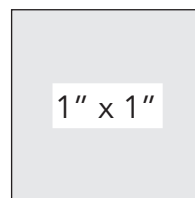


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For turned edge appliqué, cut fabric along the solid line. Cut paper templates, if desired, along the dashed line.

For raw edge appliqué, cut fabric along the dashed line or trace dashed line to paper backed fusible web.



Print at 100%.
