

Finished Placemat Size: 16" x 19"

Yardages are for making a total of (8) placemats -- (4) using panel rectangles, and (4) using panel

squares.

1 repeat: DCX9106 navy 1 1/4y: CX9108 coral

5/8y: CM0376 glimmer, CX9105 cream, CX9109 navy, DCX9102 blue

1/2y: CX9108 cream

Backing fabric: (8) 18" x 21" pieces (2 1/8y of 42" wide fabric)

5/8y	Cut for a. panel rectangle placemats (7) 1" x wof. Subcut (8) 1" x 11 1/2" and (8) 1" x 15 1/2" rectangles. b. panel square placemats (3) 1" x wof. Subcut (8) 1" x 4 1/2" and (8) 1" x 5 1/2" rectangles. (4) 1 1/2" x wof. Subcut (8) 1 1/2" x 16 1/2" rectangle.s
5/8y	Cut for a. panel rectangle placemats (4) 2 1/2" x wof. Subcut (8) 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" and (8) 2 1/2" x 10" rectangles.\ b. panel square placemats (4) 2" x wof. Subcut (8) 2" x 7 1/2" and (8) 2" x 10 1/2" rectangles.
1 1/4y	Cut for a. placemats binding (16) 2 1/4" x wof. Piece (2) wof strips to make a continuous binding strip for (1) placemat. b. panel square placemats (2) 1 1/2" x wof. Subcut (8) 1 1/2" x 10 1/2" rectangles.
1/2y	Cut for a. panel rectangle placemats (2) 1 1/2" x wof. Subcut (8) 1 1/2" x 9 1/2" rectangles. (4) 1 1/2" x wof. Subcut (9) 1 1/2" x 14 1/2" rectangles. b. panel square placemats (2) 2 1/2" x wof. Subcut (8) 2 1/2" x 10 1/2" rectangles.
5/8y	Cut for a. panel rectangle placemats (4) 2 1/2" x wof. Subfut (8) 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" and (8) 2 1/2" x 10" rectangles. a. panel square placemats (4) 1 1/2" x wof. Subcut (8) 1 1/2" x 5 1/2" and (8) 1 1/2" x 7 1/2" rectangles.
5/8y	Cut for a. panel square placemats (1) 16 1/2" x wof. Subcut (8) 4" x 16 1/2" rectangles.

(4) 9 1/2" x 12 1/2" rectangles, centering design

b. panel square placemats

(4) 4 1/2" x 4 1/2" squares, centering design

### **Constructing Panel Rectangle Placemats**


1 repeat

- 1. Inner border #1. Sew (2) 1 1/2" x 9 1/2" **Fabric D** rectangles to the opposite short sides of (1) 9 1/2" x 12 1/2" Fabric F panel rectangle, followed by (2) 1 1/2" x 14 1/2" Fabric D rectangles to the remaining opposite long sides sof the panel rectangle.
- 2. Inner border #2. Sew (2) 1" x 11 1/2" **Fabric A** rectangles to the opposite short sides of placemat center, followed by (2) 1" x 15 1/2" Fabric A rectangles to the remaining opposite long sides of




placemat center.

3. Sew together (1) 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" **Fabric B** and (1) 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" **Fabric E** rectangles along the short sides to make a column unit. Make (2) column units, and sew to the opposite short sides of placemat center.



Sew together (1) 2 1/2" x 10" **Fabric B** and (1) 2 1/2" x 10" **Fabric E** rectangles along the short sides to make a row unit. Make (2) row units, and sew to the remaining opposite long sides of placemat center to complete (1) placemat top. Make a total of (4) placemat tops.



### **Constructing Panel Square Placemats**


1. Sew (2) 1" x 4 1/2" **Fabric A** rectangles to the opposite sides of (1) 4 1/2" x 4 1/2" **Fabric G** panel square, followed by (2) 1" x 5 1/2" **Fabric A** rectangles to the remaining opposite sides of the same **Fabric G** 4 1/2" x 4 1/2" square.



- 2. Sew (2) 1 1/2" x 5 1/2" **Fabric E** rectangles to the opposite sides of placemat center, followed by (2) 1 1/2" x 7 1/2" **Fabric E** rectangles to the remaining opposite sides of placemat center.
- 3. Sew (2) 2" x 7 1/2" **Fabric B** rectangles to the opposite sides of placemat center, followed by (2) 2" x 10 1/2" **Fabric B** rectangles to the remaining opposite sides of placemat center.



4. Add to the top and bottom of placemat center (2) 1 1/2" x 10 1/2" Fabric C rectangles, followed by (2) 2 1/2" x 10 1/2" Fabric D rectangles, as shown.



5. Add to the left and right of placemat center (2) 1 1/2" x 16 1/2" **Fabric A** rectangles, followed by (2) 4" x 16 1/2" **Fabric F** rectangles to complete placemat top. Make a total of (4) placemat tops.
