## CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS FOR APPLIQUÉ PIECES

1. Assemble Templates for Hat 1 and Hat 2. Remember to trace patterns as shown and in reverse following the cutting instructions on page 2. Trace solid outer line and dashed inner line of the Hat templates to a rectangle of paper backed fusible webbing. (Hat 1 is shown below.)
2. Cut out center of fusible webbing along the inner line. This will allow you to only apply fusible webbing to the outer edge of the hat shape and later trim background fabric in step 7.
3. Carefully fuse the webbing to the wrong side of the fabric.
4. Cut out along the solid outer line. Repeat steps 1-4 for Hat 2, Hat 3 Brim and Crown and $\mathbf{K}$ Hatband 3 pieces. Trace remaining appliqué pieces to fusible webbing and cut out.


## HAT 1 BLOCK

5. Fuse (1) K Hat 1 to (1) A 10-1/2" square. Fuse (1) D Hatband 1, (1) L Flower and (1) D Flower Center to hat. Zigzag stitch around the pieces using matching thread.
6. Following step 5, make another block using (1) K Hat 1 reversed, (1) E Hatband reversed, (1) $\mathbf{N}$ Flower and 1) E Flower Center.
7. Turn blocks over so wrong side is facing up. Trim A fabric as close as possible to the inside edge of zigzag stitching along crown and brim so dark print doesn't show through white hat.

White zigzag stitching is shown in red for contrast.

## HAT 2 BLOCK

8. Fuse (1) K Hat 2 to (1) A 10-1/2" square. Fuse (1) D Hatband 2, (1) M Flower and (1) E Flower Center to hat. Zigzag stitch around the pieces using matching thread.
9. Following step 8, make another block using (1) K Hat 1 reversed, (1) E Hatband reversed, (1) $\mathbf{N}$ Flower and 1) M Flower Center.
10. Following step 7, trim fabric close to inside edge of zigzag stitching.


## HAT 3

11. Fuse (1) $\mathbf{F}$ Hat 3 Brim to position on (1) $\mathbf{K} 10-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square slanted as indicated. Fuse (1) $\mathbf{D}$ Hat 3 Crown to Brim. Fuse (1) O Hatband 3 and (1) E Bow to Hat. Zigzag stitch along the edges of the pieces using matching thread.
12. Following step 11, make another block slanting the hat in the opposite direction.
13. Follow Step 7 to trim the $\mathbf{K}$ fabric from the center of the Brim and Crown, if desired.

14. Following steps 11-13, make (2) Hat 3 blocks using $\mathbf{K}$ 10-1/2" squares, J Brims, J Crowns, $\mathbf{K}$ Hatbands and $\mathbf{E}$ Bows as shown.
15. Following steps 11 and 13, make (1) Hat 3 block with hat centered straight on block using K 10-1/2" square, G Brim, E Crown, O Hatband and D Bow as shown.

## QUILT ASSEMBLY

16. Following the Quilt Layout on page 7, arrange the blocks in 3 rows of 3 blocks each. Arrange (1) B 1-3/4" $\times 10-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle and (1) C 1-3/4" $\times 10-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle between the blocks. Sew together (3) blocks alternating with (2) rectangles to make the block rows.
17. Arrange (2) B 1-3/4" $\times 10-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles and (1) C $1-3 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 10-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle for sashing row 1. Sew together (3) rectangles alternating with (2) E 1-3/4" squares.
18. Arrange (2) C 1-3/4" $\times 10-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles and (1) B 1-3/4" $\times 10-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle for sashing row 2 . Sew together (3) rectangles alternating with (2) E 1-3/4" squares.
19. Sew together (3) blocks rows alternating with (2) sashing rows.
20. Sew the short edge of (1) H $2^{\prime \prime} \times 36-3 / 4$ " borders to each side of quilt beginning and ending stitching $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ from edge of quilt. Sew diagonal ends of adjacent borders together.
21. Sew together (2) $\mathbf{K} 1^{\prime \prime} \times 36^{\prime \prime}$ strips alternating with (1) $\mathbf{D} 1 " \times 36^{\prime \prime}$ strip to make $\mathbf{K} / \mathbf{D}$ border units. Make 4.
22. Sew (1) K/D border unit to each side of quilt. Sew (2) E 2" squares to ends of (2) border units. Sew to top and bottom of quilt.
23. Sew (1) $\boldsymbol{I} 5-1 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 39$ " border to each side of quilt. Sew (2) I $5-1 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 48-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ borders to top and bottom of quilt.
24. Trace scallop border pattern to sides of quilt repeating pattern 5 times. Trace scallop corner pattern to corners of quilt.

## Quilt Layout






FINISHING: Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich. Baste and quilt as desired. Trim borders along scalloped line. Bind using five fabric A 2-1/4" strips.
