

KEY	CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS
Α	(2) 4-1/2" x 41-1/2" length of fabric borders. (4) 4-1/2" x 42" width of fabric strips; sew short ends together. Subcut (2) 4-1/2" x 51-1/2" borders.
В	(18) Diamond Template 2.
С	(4) 2" x 42" strips; subcut (4) 2-1/2" x 21-1/2" strips and (4) 2" x 18-1/2" strips. (10) Diamond Template 1.
D	(8) Diamond Template 1.
E	FOR BINDING:  (6) 2-1/4" x 42" strips, sew short ends together.  (8) Diamond Template 2 reversed.
F	(5) 1-1/2" x 42"; sew short ends together. Subcut (2) 1-1/2" x 43-1/2" borders and (2) 1-1/2" x 39-1/2" borders. (10) Diamond Template 2 reversed.
G	Fussy-cut (1) 21-1/2" x 18-1/2" rectangle, centered over "Much Loved Bear" Panel. Fussy-cut (4) 10-1/2" x 11" rectangles centered over small panels.
Н	<ul> <li>(5) 1-1/2" x 42"; sew short ends together.</li> <li>Subcut (2) 1-1/2" x 53-1/2" borders and <ul> <li>(2) 1-1/2" x 49-1/2" borders.</li> </ul> </li> <li>(2) 1-1/2" x 42" strips; subcut (4) 1-1/2" x 21-1/2" strips.</li> <li>(2) 2" x 42" strips; subcut (4) 2" x 18-1/2" strips</li> <li>(36) Triangle Templates and (36) Triangle Templates reversed.</li> </ul>







### **BLOCKS**


- **1.** Sew (1) **B** Diamond Template 2 to (1) **F** Diamond Template 2 reversed beginning 1/4" from the edge to make a diamond pair.
- **2.** Sew fabric **F** edge of diamond pair to (1) **C** Diamond Template 1 ending stitching 1/4" from the edge.
- **3.** Sew fabric **B** edge of diamond pair to **C** Diamond Template 1 beginning stitching 1/4" from the edge to complete block shape.




- **4.** Sew (2) **H** Triangle Templates to opposite sides of block. Sew (2) **H** Triangle Templates reversed to remaining edges to make a rectangle. Blocks should measure slightly less that 4-1/4" x 5" including seam allowance. Make 6.
- **5.** Following steps 1-4, make blocks using the fabrics shown. Make the number indicated.










- **6.** Sew together (3) Block 1 alternating with (2) Block 2. Block strip should measure  $21-1/2" \times 5"$  including seam allowances.
- 7. Sew (2) H 1-1/2" x 21-1/2" strip to top and bottom of horizontal block row.
- **8.** Sew (2)  $\mathbb{C}$  2-1/2" x 21-1/2" strips to top and bottom of  $\mathbb{H}$  strips to complete top and bottom strip. Top and bottom strip should measure 21-1/2" x 11" including seam allowances. Make 2.

- **9.** Sew together (2) Block 3 alternating with (2) Block 4. Note position of blocks in each strip.
- **10.** Sew (2) **H** 2" x 18-1/2" strip to sides of vertical block row.
- **11.** Sew (2) **C** 2" x 18-1/2" strips to sides of **H** strips to complete side block strip. Side strip should measure 18-1/2" x 10-1/2" including seam allowances. Trim side edges evenly if strip is too wide. Make 1 each.



### **Quilt Assembly**

- **12.** Following the Quilt Layout on page 5, sew (1) side block strip to sides of **G** 21-3/4" x 18-1/2" rectangle to make quilt center.
- **13.** Sew (2) **G** 10-1/2" x 11" rectangles to ends of top and bottom strip. Sew to top and bottom of quilt center matching seams.
- **14.** Sew (1)  $\mathbf{F}$  1-1/2" x 39-1/2" border to each side of quilt. Sew (2)  $\mathbf{F}$  1-1/2" x 43-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt.
- **15**. Sew (1)  $\mathbf{A}$  4-1/2" x 41-1/2" border to each side of quilt. Sew (2)  $\mathbf{A}$  4-1/2" x 51-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt.
- **16.** Sew (1) **H** 1-1/2"  $\times$  49-1/2" border to each side of quilt. Sew (2) **A** 1-1/2"  $\times$  53-1/2" borders to top and bottom of quilt.




### Quilt Layout



**FINISHING:** Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich. Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using six fabric **E** 2-1/4" strips.
