ROUND UP TREE SKIRT

KEY	CUTTING INTRUCTIONS
A	Cut (3) 4- 1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut into (30) 60 degree triangles (see diagram below).
B	Cut (3) 4- 1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut into (30) 60 degree triangles (see diagram below).
C	Cut (2) 4- 1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut into (15) 60 degree triangles; or 18 if doing the table topper option (see diagram below).
D	Cut (2) 4- 1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut into (15) 60 degree triangles; or 18 if doing the table topper option (see diagram below).
E	Cut (6) 4- 1/2" x WOF strips Subcut into (6) 4- 1/2" x 28" rectangles
F	Cut (7) 2- 1/4" x WOF strips for binding



Cutting Notes:

1. For the best cutting results please use a 60 degree ruler.
2. Multi-directional fabric was selected for this project so that all triangles could be used.

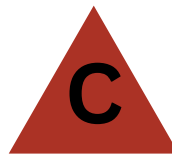


ROUND UP TREE SKIRT

Section 1 Assembly (Make 3):

1. Begin assembling Section 1 by sewing the triangles together across Row 1, Row 2, and Row 3.
2. Sew Row 1 to Row 2 making sure the bases of the B and D triangles are aligned.
3. Sew Row 3 to Rows 1 & 2, making sure that the bases of the A and C triangles are aligned.
4. Sew an E strip to the bottom of Rows 1-3, making sure that is centered. If you are making the Table Topper version you will also want to attach a C triangle to the top of Rows 1-3 making sure that the base aligns with the base of the A triangle.

ROUND UP TREE SKIRT

Section 2 Assembly (Make 3):

1. Begin assembling Section 2 by sewing the triangles together across Row 1, Row 2, and Row 3.
2. Sew Row 1 to Row 2 making sure the bases of the A and C triangles are aligned.
3. Sew Row 3 to Rows 1 & 2, making sure that the bases of the B and D triangles are aligned.
4. Sew an E strip to the bottom of Rows 1-3, making sure that is centered. If you are making the Table Topper version you will also want to attach a D triangle to the top of Rows 1-3 making sure that the base aligns with the base of the B triangle.

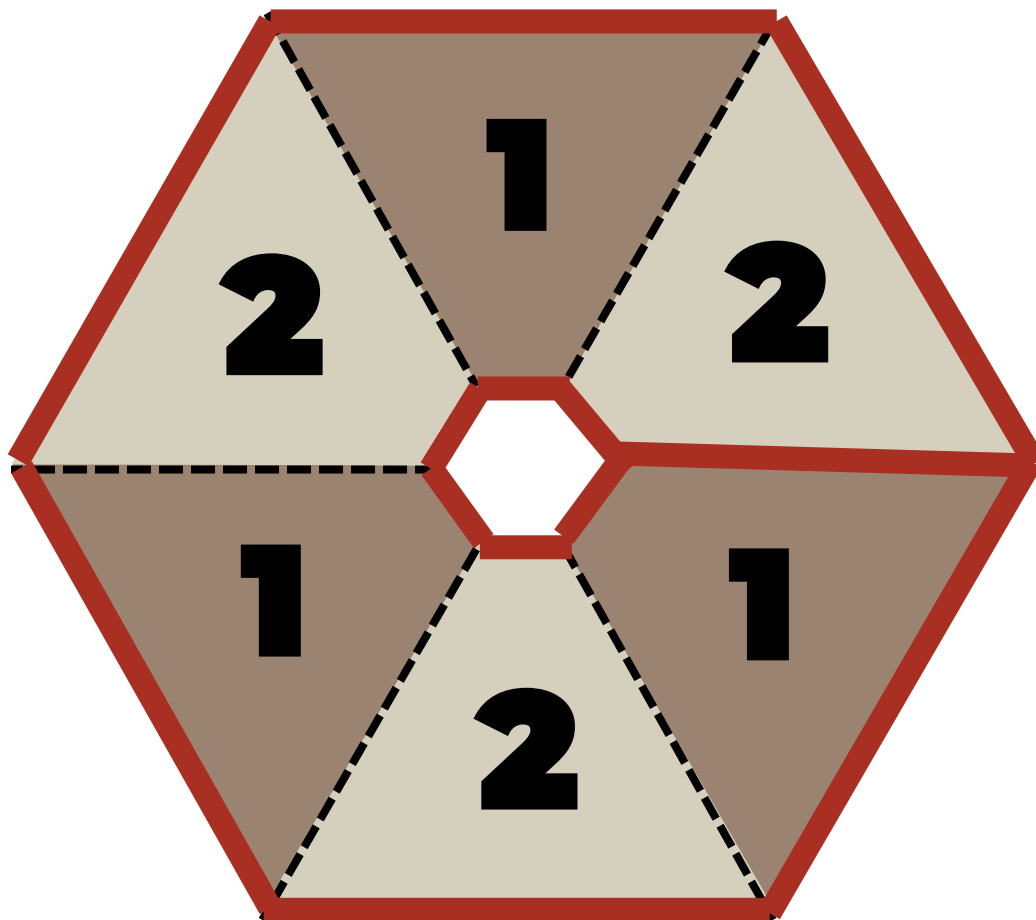

ROUND UP TREE SKIRT

Tree Skirt Assembly:

1. Sew together Sections 1 & 2 so that they form a hexagon, making sure to alternate the sections. You will want to leave one seam open to act as the back of your tree skirt.
(See diagram below.)
2. Sew your backing fabric together and then layer your tree skirt with the backing right side face down, batting, and top right side face up.
3. Quilt using desired pattern (a radial pattern from the center out works well), making sure to leave the one seam open.
4. Trim quilted tree skirt, being careful to cut the open seam and the interior hexagon.
5. Using the binding strips, make binding and bind around all tree skirt edges. (See diagram below.)
6. Attach optional closures, if desired.



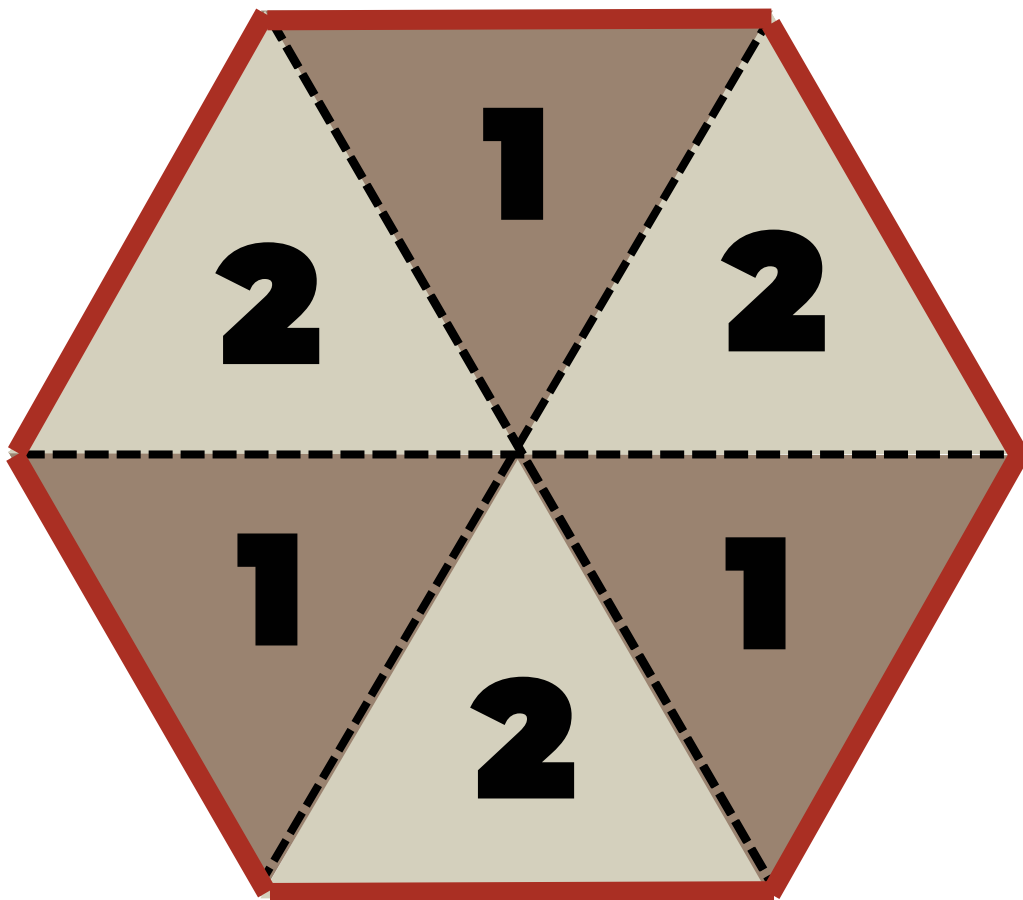
----- Sewing Line

ROUND UP TREE SKIRT

Optional Table Topper Version Assembly:

1. Sew together Sections 1 & 2 so that they form a hexagon, making sure to alternate the sections. (See diagram below.)
2. Sew your backing fabric together and then layer your table topper with the backing right side face down, batting, and top right side face up.
3. Quilt using desired pattern (a radial pattern from the center out works well).
4. Trim quilted table topper.
5. Using the binding strips, make binding and bind around the table topper.
