## ADDITIONAL MATERIALS

1 yard backing fabric
Thread to match fabrics
Basic sewing supplies
Template plastic

Sewing machine
Rotary cutter, ruler and mat

## BLOCKS

1. Sew (1) I Side Diamond to (1) J Side Diamond reversed, beginning stitching at upper end of the seamline.
2. Sew J Side Diamond to (1) A Top Diamond ending at the corner of the seamline.
3. Sew I Side diamond to adjacent side A Top Diamond beginning at corner of seamline to make a cube unit. Be careful so J Diamond is not caught in the seamline.

4. Sew (2) $\boldsymbol{D}$ Triangles to opposite sides of cube unit. Sew (2) $\boldsymbol{D}$ Triangles reversed to remaining sides to make a square.
5. Sew (1) D 1-1/2" $\times 7^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle to each side of square.
6. Sew (2) D 1-1/4" $\times 8-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle to top and bottom of square. Make 2 .

7. Following steps 1-6, make blocks using the fabrics as shown. Make the number of blocks indicated.

## ASSEMBLY

8. Following the Quilt Layout on page 5, arrange the blocks in (3) rows of (3) blocks each.

Sew together (3) blocks alternating with (2) C $1^{\prime \prime} \times 8-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips to make the block rows. Make 3.
9. Sew together (3) block rows alternating with (2) C 1 " $\times 25-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips.
10. Sew (1) A $1^{\prime \prime} \times 25-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ border to each side of the quilt. Sew (2) A $1^{\prime \prime} \times 26-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ border to top and bottom of the quilt.
11. Sew (1) $\mathbf{H} 1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 26-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ border to each side of the quilt. Sew (2) $\mathbf{I} 1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 28-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ borders to top and bottom of quilt.

FINISHING: Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich. Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using three fabric J 2-1/4" strips.
