| E | (1) $4-7 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 42^{\prime \prime}$ strip; subcut (7) Border Triangle Templates. Alternate triangles across strip to conserve fabric. <br> (1) $5-3 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 42^{\prime \prime}$ strip; subcut (2) $5-3 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares and (2) Border Triangle Templates. Cut squares in half diagonally once to make (4) $5-3 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ triangles. |
| F | (8) $2^{\prime \prime} \times 42^{\prime \prime}$ strips; sew short ends together. Subcut (4) $2^{\prime \prime} \times 45-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ borders and <br> (4) $2^{\prime \prime} \times 28-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ borders. |
| G | (4) $2^{\prime \prime} \times 31-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ borders. |
| H | FOR BINDING: <br> (5) $2-1 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 42^{\prime \prime}$ strips, sew short ends together. (7) $1-3 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 42^{\prime \prime}$ strips; sew short ends together. Subcut (4) 1-3/4" $\times 43^{\prime \prime}$ borders and <br> (4) $1-3 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 19^{\prime \prime}$ borders. <br> (4) 2" squares. |
| I | (4) 1-3/4" squares. <br> (2) $2-7 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares; cut squares in half diagonally once to make (4) triangles. |

## ADDITIONAL MATERIALS

2-1/2 yards backing fabric
Thread to match fabrics
Sewing machine
Basic sewing supplies
Rotary cutter, ruler and mat

Template plastic
Optional: 1/4 yard lightweight fusible interfacing

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## TEMPLATES FOR FUSSY-CUTTING

1. Make templates for the Center Square, Corner Triangle, Border Triangle, Large Corner Square and Small Corner Square, using the measurements given. Mark the seamline $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ from the edges, if desired. Cut Templates from fabrics as shown. Center square is cut with arrow on the straight grain.

Optional: Cut (16) 1/4" $\times$ 9-1/4 strips from lightweight fusibe interfacing. Fuse to seam allowance of center square to prevent bias edges from stretching during sewing.


## QUILT CENTER

2. Sew (2) A center blocks together in pairs to make (1) half block. Make 2.
3. Sew (2) half blocks together to make quilt center. Make 1.


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## CORNER TRIANGLE

4. Sew (1) C Corner Triangle and (1) D Corner Triangle together to make (1) square unit. Note orientation of print on $\mathbf{D}$ triangles.
5. Sew (2) D Corner Triangles to sides of square

## PATCHWORK BORDER

6. Sew together (4) B Border Triangles alternating with (3) E Border Triangles. Note orientation of print on $\mathbf{B}$ triangles. Sew (2) E5-3/8" triangles to ends to make a rectangle. Make 4 borders as shown in Quilt Layout on page 5.


## QUILT ASSEMBLY

7. Following the Quilt Layout on page 5, sew (2) H $1-3 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 19^{\prime \prime}$ borders to opposite sides of the quilt center. Sew (2) I2-7/8" triangles to ends of (2) H $1-3 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 19^{\prime \prime}$ borders. Note orientation of triangles. Sew to remaining sides of the quilt center.
8. Sew (1) C/D corner triangle unit to each side of the quilt.
9. Sew (2) F $2^{\prime \prime} \times 28-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ borders to sides of the quilt. Sew (2) A Small Corner Square Templates to ends of (2) $\mathbf{F} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 28-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ borders. Sew to top and bottom of quilt.
10. Sew (2) G $2^{\prime \prime} \times 31-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ borders to sides of quilt. Sew (2) H 2" squares to ends of
(2) $\mathbf{G} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 31-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ borders. Sew to top and bottom of quilt.
11. Sew (2) Patchwork Borders to sides of the quilt. Sew (2) D Large Corner Square Templates to ends of (2) Patchwork Borders. Sew to top and bottom of quilt.
12. Sew (2) H $1-3 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 43^{\prime \prime}$ borders to sides of quilt. Sew (2) $\mathbf{I} 1-3 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ squares to ends of (2) $\mathbf{H} 1-3 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 43^{\prime \prime}$ borders. Sew to top and bottom of quilt.
13. Sew (2) F $2^{\prime \prime} \times 45-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ borders to sides of the quilt. Sew (2) A Small Corner Square Templates to ends of (2) $\mathbf{F} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 45-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ borders. Sew to top and bottom of quilt.

FINISHING: Layer quilt top, batting and backing together to form quilt sandwich. Baste and quilt as desired. Bind using five fabric H 2-1/4" strips.
