SHARPIE CADDY ROLL INSTRUCTIONS

FABRIC

3 different fat quarters 9" x 13" cotton batting Ribbon

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

Cut the following fabric (please take note if the fabric print is directional) From fabric A – One 9"h x 13"w – outside piece

From fabric B –
One 6" h x 13"w – pocket piece
One 5" h x 13" w – flap piece

From fabric C –
One 9"h x 13" – lining piece
One 5"h x 13"w – lining flap piece

SEWING INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Take the pocket piece, fold ½ inch from the top of the fabric then press. Fold another ½ inch. Press and top stitch.
- 2. Lay the pocket piece on top of the lining piece, matching the bottom of each fabric. Baste stitch 1/2" from either edge of the pieces to hold them together.
- 3. Sew vertical lines every 1" from the ½" mark (back stitch on the start and the end) throughout the piece. Set aside.



4. Take the outside flap piece and inside flap piece and lay them RST. Sew the pieces starting at the top corner at ½" seam allowance at either side and taper down to 1" seam allowance from either side at the bottom corner and sew three sides to form a tapered flap, leaving the top open. Trim the seam allowance all around and turn it right side out.





5. Center the flap piece on to the right side of the lining piece and baste.



6. If you're planning to fancy up your outside piece, now's the time. I quilted mine with 1" vertical lines. Cut 2' ribbon and fold it in half (RST), and sandwich it between the outside piece and lining piece (RST) and pin.



7. Sew all around, with ½" seam allowance, leaving 3" open on one side to turn it over. Make sure to back stitch on the start and the end. Cut the corner seam allowance and trim the seam allowance all over.

8. Turn it over right side out. Using a chopstick, poke on the corners to make sure the corners are squared off and press. Slip stitch the opening and top stitch all over. Put your sharpies andenjoy!
